Dear Mr. McNeil:

Kentucky Power Company ("Kentucky Power" or the "Company") provides notice, pursuant to the Commission's Order in Case No. 2025-00031, that on August 31, 2026, the Company recorded expenses associated with the August 11, 2026 and August 16, 2026 major storm events as a regulatory asset for accounting purposes only to be recorded in the August 2026 financial close. At the time of recording, the amount of the regulatory asset was \$6,398,117. This is a preliminary estimate of the costs associated with recovery from the storm, and the costs are subject to change. Kentucky Power will file an application within 90 days of the storm seeking approval for establishing the regulatory asset.
