Availability of Service:

Available to members of the Cooperative for Farm, Home, School, Church, Community Hall, Store, Service Station and other permanent type loads with a transformer capacity requirement of 100 KVA or less but excluding Coal Mine, Oil Well and other temporary loads. The availability of service is subject to all of the rules and regulations that may be established from time to time by the Cooperative. (T)

Type of Service:

- A. Single Phase, 120-240 volts, or
- B. Three Phase, 240/480 volts, or
- C. Three Phase, 120/208 wye volts

Rates:

First	15 KWH, or less, per month	\$1.50 per month
Next	10 KWH per month	7.5¢ per KWH
Next	25 KWH per month	6.5¢ per KWH
Next	50 KWH per month	3.5¢ per KWH
Next	100 KWH per Month	1.75¢ per KWH
Over	200 KWH Per month	1.25¢ per KWH

Minimum Charges:

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$1.50. For members requiring more than 3 KVA of transformer capacity, the minimum monthly charge shall be increased at the rate of 75¢ for each

additional KVA fraction thereof required. Payment of the minimum charge shall entitle the member in all cases to the use of the number of Kilowatt-hours corresponding to the minimum charge in accordance with the foregoing rate.

Delayed Payments:

In the event the current monthly bill is not paid by the 13th day of the following month, for which service is rendered, the service shall be discontinued and a reconnect or service charge of \$2.50, in addition to the bill for service, shall be made prior to the restoration of service. This charge shall be made whether or not the service is physically disconnected. The Cooperative shall require a cash payment prior to the restoration of service after the 13th day of the following month for which service is received.

Special Rules:

- A. The rated capacity of a single-phase motor shall not be in excess of ten horsepower (10 H.P.)
- B. Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10 H.P.) must be three phase.
- C. Service under this schedule is limited to consumers whose load requirements can be met by transformers having a capacity not to exceed 100 KVA. Consumers requiring more than 100 KVA shall be served under an appropriate schedule for large power service. (T)
- D. Seasonal or temporary loads such as coal mines and oil wells are excluded from service under this schedule.
