Applicable:

Entire territory served.

Availability of Service:

Available to Coal Mines, Oil Wells and/or other temporary loads which are excluded from Schedule A1.

Type of Service:

Single phase and three-phase 120-208-240 volts.

Rates:

First	15 KWH, or less per month @	\$1.50 per month
Next	10 KWH, per month @	8.0¢ per KWH
Next	25 KWH, per month @	7.0¢ per KWH
Next	50 KWH, per month @	4.0¢ per KWH
Next	2900 KWH, per month @	2.5¢ per KWH
Over	3000 KWH, per month @	1.75¢ per KWH

Minimum Monthly Charge:

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$1.50 where 3 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For consumers requiring more than 3 KVA of transformer capacity the minimum monthly charge shall be increased at the rate of 75¢ for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required.

Minimum Annual Charge for Seasonal Service:

Consumers requiring service during, but not to exceed nine months

Availability:

Available to farm and home consumers who have in regular use a water heater conforming to the specifications set forth hereunder and who are receiving service at the same location for other usages. The rate capacity of any motor served under this schedule shall not exceed ten (10) horsepower.

Type of Service:

Single-phase, sixty (60) cycles, at available secondary voltage.

Rate:

First 15 KWH per month @	10¢ per KWH
Next 10 KWH per month @	7¢ per KWH
Next 25 KWH per month @	6¢ per KWH
Next 50 KWH per month @	3¢ per KWH
Next 100 KWH per month @	2¢ per KWH
Next 300 KWH per month @	1 ¢ per KWH
Over 500 KWH per month @	1½¢ per KWH

Minimum Charges:

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$1.50 where three (3) kva transformer capacity if required. For members requiring more than three (3) kva of transformer capacity, the minimum monthly charge shall be increased at the rate of 75¢ for each additional kva or fraction thereof required. Payment of the minimum charge shall entitle the member in all cases to the use of the number of kilowatt-hours corresponding to the minimum charge in accordance with the foregoing rate.

RATE PER UNIT

Conditions of Service:

1. The consumer shall install and operate in regular use a standard approved storage type Electric Water Heater and shall have no non-electric household water heating device in use during any part of the year (such as heating coils in a fuel-burning range or furnace).
2. Regardless of number of storage type water heaters connected to any single service, only one block of 300 KWH per month @ 1¢ per KWH will be allowed for any one service.
3. The Cooperative reserves the right to install an off peak control device at its option.

Definition of Approved Water Heater:

For the purpose of this rate, an approved storage type, Electric Water Heater is defined as follows:

An Electric Water Heater installed in accordance to the National Electric Safety Code and Cooperative Policy and with a lower element of 20 watts per gallon increased to the next largest commercial rating and an upper element of 30 watts per gallon increased to the next largest commercial size. The elements shall in no case be larger than the above ratings.

Delayed Payment Charge:

In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within fifteen (15) days from the date of the bill, five percent (5%) will be added to the bill.

Special Rules:

Service under this schedule is limited to individual motors up to and including ten horsepower (10 H.P.).

Availability

Available to consumers located on or near Seller's three-phase lines for all types of usage, subject to the established rules and regulations of Seller.

Rate

\$ 1.25 per month per KW of billing demand;
Plus energy charges of -
2.5¢ per kWh for the first 50 kWh used per month per KW of billing demand
1.5¢ per kWh for the next 100 kWh used per month per KW of billing demand
1.3¢ per kWh for all remaining kWh used per month

Determination of Billing Demand

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the consumer for any period fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter and adjusted for power factor as follows:

Power Factor Adjustment

The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Demand charges will be adjusted for consumers with 50 KW or more of measured demand to correct for average power factors lower than 90%, and may be so adjusted for other consumers if and when the seller deems necessary. Such adjustments will be made by increasing the measured demand 1% for each 1% by which the average power factor is less than 90% lagging.

Fuel Cost Adjustment Charge

In case the rate under which Seller purchases power at wholesale is adjusted in accordance with fuel cost adjustment provision in Seller's wholesale power contract, the foregoing energy charges shall be adjusted each month by the same amount per kWh as the fuel

Fuel Cost Adjustment Charge - continued

Cost adjustment per kWh in Seller's wholesale power bill for the next preceding month.

Minimum Monthly Charge

The minimum monthly charge shall be the highest one of the following charges as determined for the consumer in question:

- (1) The minimum monthly charge specified in the contract for service.
- (2) A charge of \$0.75 per KVA of installed transformer capacity.
- (3) A charge of \$25.00.

Minimum Annual Charge for Seasonal Service

Consumers requiring service only during certain seasons not exceeding nine months per year may guarantee a minimum annual payment of twelve times the minimum monthly charge determined in accordance with the foregoing section in which case there shall be no minimum monthly charge.

Type of Service

Three-phase, 60 cycles, at Seller's standard voltages.

Conditions of Service

1. Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10 H.P.) must be three-phase.

2. Both power and lighting shall be billed at the foregoing rate. If a separate meter is required for the lighting circuit, the registrations of the two watt-hour meters shall be added to obtain total kilowatt-hours used and the registrations of the two demand meters shall be added to obtain the total kilowatt demand for billing purposes.

Conditions of Service - continued

- 3. All wiring, pole lines, and other electrical equipment beyond the metering point, shall be considered the distribution system of the consumer and shall be furnished and maintained by the consumer.
- 4. If service is furnished at primary distribution voltage, a discount of ten per cent (10%) shall apply to the demand and energy charges, and if the minimum charge is based on transformer capacity, a discount of 10% shall also apply to the minimum charge. However, the Seller shall have the option of metering at secondary voltage and adding the estimated transformer losses to the metered kilowatt-hours and kilowatt demand.
