RULES AND REGULATIONS

POLICY: UNDERGROUND SERVICE

RESIDENTIAL MEMBERS:

6-73

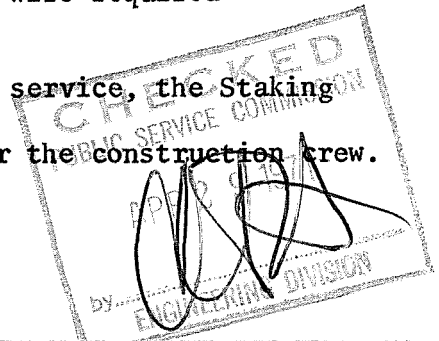
The Cooperative shall make available to the members underground electrical service on request provided said service is feasible or necessary.

PROCEDURE:

In the event consumer request underground service the Cooperative Staking Engineer will visit proposed building site and determine if underground service is possible. If the condition of the site is suitable for underground service the Staking Engineer will notify the member of the following requirements:

1. Residence must have 200 Amp entrance installed.
2. The member shall be responsible for opening and closing of trench according to Uniform Wiring Code and REA specifications.
3. The member will furnish and install the necessary entrance on building as specified by the Uniform Wiring Code.
4. The Cooperative will furnish the meter base and install the necessary entrance wires not to exceed 100 feet. The member shall pay for any additional footage of entrance wire required over 100 feet.

If this is agreeable to the member requesting underground service, the Staking Engineer will prepare the necessary installation forms for the construction crew.

FUEL CLAUSE:

The energy charge shall be increased or decreased at the rate of 0.10 mills per kilowatt hour for each 1.0 cent, or fraction thereof, by which the weighted average delivered cost of fuel burned during each month in Big Rivers' thermal generating plants exceeds or is less than 15.6 cents per million BTU. The delivered cost of fuel shall be the net cost invoiced to Big Rivers by its coal suppliers. For the purpose of facilitating the prompt mailing of bills, the fuel adjustment for any month shall be based upon the average cost of fuel and the kilowatt-hour consumed by the Member during that month, but shall appear as a credit or a debit upon the succeeding monthly bill.

TAXES:

If there shall be imposed by Federal, State, or other governmental authority, any tax payable by the Seller upon the gross revenue or earnings, or upon the production, transmission or sale of electric energy, a pro rata share of such additional tax or taxes shall be added to the monthly bill payable by the Member to the Seller. The sales tax of the State of Kentucky is not included in the Monthly Rate but, if applicable, will be paid by Member.

TAX ADJUSTMENT:

C-5-73

There shall be added to or subtracted from the monthly demand charge the following adjustment to reflect changes in the taxes imposed upon Big Rivers:

(a) In ad valorem taxes:

\$0.045 A - \$0.045 per kilowatt of Billing Demand.
(0.0024)

WHERE: A equals the ratio of total ad valorem taxes imposed upon Big Rivers for the preceding year to the average total plant investment of Big Rivers for such year,
