SERVICE PROCEDURES [ Continued ]

- 11. If a consumer request a meter test, a deposit of two dollars [\$2.00] will be made. If the meter tested registers within 2% normal, the deposit will be retained and no correction in billing will be made. Where meters do not register within 2% normal the consumers deposit will be refunded and correction in billing for the preceding three months will be made.
- 12. The consumer shall furnish and maintain all the wiring and equipment beyond the meter. All installations, wiring and equipment are subject to these rules and regulations. Wiring must be approved by the state accredited inspector before the service is connected.
- 13. If improper installation of equipment interferes with service to others, the consumer should call the Cooperative for help to remedy the trouble or see that the equipment causing the trouble is disconnected. As a last resort, service to the consumer may be disconnected.
- 14. The maximum size for a single-phase motor shall be 10 horsepower. Over that, motors should be three-phase.
- 15. Single-phase motors of more than 5 horsepower capacity and three-phase motors of 7 1/2 horsepower and larger should have approved starter equipment, with low voltage protective and current limiting devices. Motors 15 horsepower or more, Automatically starting and stopping should have starting equipment approved by the Co-op.
- 16. Consumers should notify the Cooperative of any proposed changes which will materially increase their load or involve wiring changes.

- 17. Bills will be rendered monthly and must be paid by the 1st day of the following month or else be subject to additional charges. When the first day of the month falls on a Sunday or a Holiday, the first business day thereafter will apply.
- 18. Bills will be rendered even if meter readings are not received. In such cases, the bill will be estimated and adjustments made when correct readings are obtained.
- 19. When service is commenced or discontinued between regular meter reading dates, the Co-op will prorate the minimum bill and energy blocks of the rate schedule in proportion to the number of days service is used.

Determination of Billing Demand

Power Factor Adjustment

The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practical. Demand charges will be adjusted for consumers with 50 kw or more of measured demand to correct for average power factors lower than 90%, and may be so adjusted for other consumers if and when the Seller deems necessary. Such adjustments will be made by increasing the measured demand 1% by which the average power factor is less than 90% lagging.

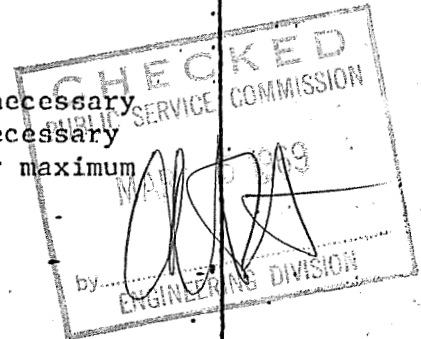

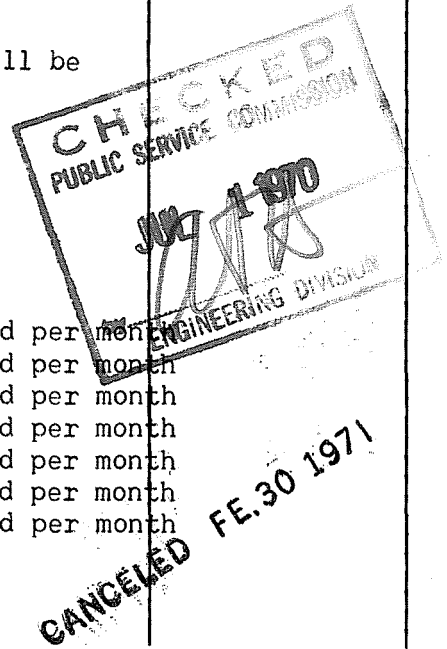

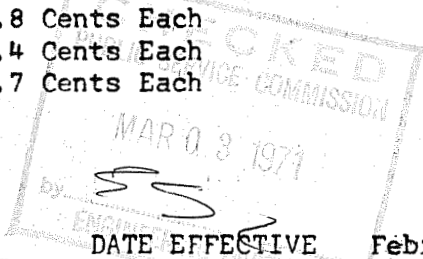

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

SERVICE PROCEDURES

(1) Each consumer shall sign a membership application and pay a fee of \$15.00. When a consumer's service is disconnected his membership fee will be applied to any unpaid bill of the consumer, if any balance remains after such application is made, this balance will be refunded to the consumer.

(2) Every home will be separately metered and billed. If a consumer desires service at two or more locations, they will be required to sign a membership application and pay a \$15.00 membership fee for each service.

(3) The consumer signing the membership application shall be responsible for the monthly bill.

(4) Collection Policy: Bills are due the first of the month and are delinquent if not paid by the 10th of the month. Notice of this policy will appear on consumer's monthly bill card. If the cooperative has to come to the consumer's house or other location to collect the bill, charge of \$2.00 (two dollars) will be added to the bill. If the service is disconnected for non-payment an additional \$2.00 will be added to the bill and will be paid before service is reconnected.

(5) Returned Checks: If the cooperative has to come to the consumer's house or other location to collect a check that has been returned by the bank a charge of \$2.00 will be made. N

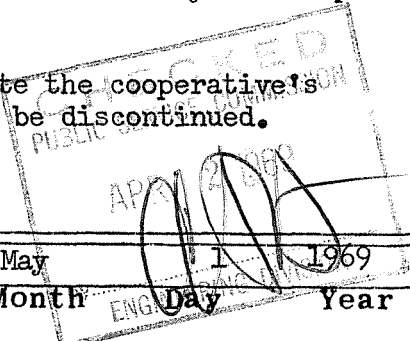
(6) Moving Charge: If a consumer moves from one location to another, there will be a charge of \$2.00 for disconnection and reconnection.

(7) Meters: Each consumer shall read his meter on the last day of each month and return the meter reading to the cooperative office by the 10th of the following month.

(8) Meter Reading Policy: If any consumer fails to read his meter or return his reading to the cooperative office by the 10th of the month for two (2) consecutive months, our serviceman will automatically read the meter and a two dollar (\$2.00) service charge will be placed against his account.

(9) If the meter is read incorrectly an appropriate adjustment will be made by the cooperative billing department.

(10) Under no circumstances shall a consumer tamper with or mutilate the cooperative's metering equipment. If irregularities are confirmed, service will be discontinued.
