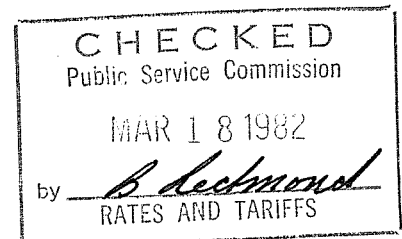
**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**26. DEPOSITS**

The Cooperative may require from any consumer or applicant for service a minimum cash deposit or guaranty to secure payment of bills of any amount not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the estimated annual bill of such consumer or applicant.
