Domestic-Farm and Home Service - Schedule 1A.

RATE PER UNIT

Availability:

Available to members of the Cooperative for all farm and home uses subject to its established rules and regulations. The capacity of individual single-phase motors served under this schedule may not exceed ten (10) horsepower and the capacity of three-phase motors served under this schedule may not exceed thirty (30) horsepower.

Type of Service:

Single-phase 60 cycle at 120/240 volt alternating current, or where available three-phase 4 wire 120/240 volt, 60 cycle alternating current, but not to exceed a total of 30 KVA of transformer capacity.

Rate:

First	15 KWH or less per month	\$1.50	
Next	35 KWH ●	.057 per	KWH
Next	50 KWH ●	.03 per	KWH
Next	100 KWH ●	.025 per	KWH
Next	200 KWH ●	.019 per	KWH
Next	600 KWH ●	.013 per	KWH
Over	1000 KWH ●	.012 per	KWH

Minimum Charge:

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$1.50 where 25 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For members requiring more than 25 KVA of transformer capacity the minimum monthly charge shall be increased at the rate of 75¢ for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required. Payment of the minimum charge shall entitle the consumer in all cases to the use of the number of kilowatt hours corresponding to the minimum charge in accordance with the foregoing rate.

Terms of Payment:

The above rates are net and are due on the first day of each month.

This Schedule supersedes Schedule 1.

Schedule 3B-
Public Buildings-Schools, Churches, Camps, Barns, Out-Buildings and
seasonal residences.

RATE
PER UNIT

Availability:

Available to public buildings, schools, churches, camps, barns,
out-buildings, and seasonal residences for all uses provided the re-
quired transformer capacity does not exceed 25 KVA; and subject to the
Cooperative's established rules and regulations covering this type of
service. Service under this schedule is limited to individual motors
up to and including ten horsepower (10 H.P.).

Type of Service:

Single-phase, 60 cycle at 120/240, alternating current.

Note: In case three-phase service is re-
quired Schedule 2A or 4A shall apply.

Rate:

First	15 KWH or less per month	\$1.50	
Next	35 KWH @	.057 per	KWH
Next	50 KWH @	.03 per	KWH
Next	100 KWH @	.025 per	KWH
Next	200 KWH @	.019 per	KWH
Next	600 KWH @	.013 per	KWH
Over	1000 KWH @	.012 per	KWH

Minimum Charge:

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$1.50
where 25 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For con-
sumers requiring more than 25 KVA of transformer capacity the minimum
monthly charge shall be increased at the rate of 75¢ for each additional
KVA or fraction thereof required. For temporary or seasonal service
a minimum charge of \$18.00 is required payable at time of request for
service. Payment of the minimum charge shall entitle the consumer in
all cases to the use of the number of kilowatt hours corresponding
to the minimum charge in accordance with the foregoing rate.

CLASSIFICATION OF SERVICE

Large Power Service - Schedule 4A.

RATE PER UNIT

Availability:

Available to consumers located on or near Cooperative's three-phase lines for all types of usage, subject to the established rules and regulations of the Cooperative.

Type of Service:

Three-phase, 60 cycles, at Cooperative's standard voltages.

Rate:

Demand Charges

\$1.25 per month per KW of billing demand.

Plus Energy Charges

2.0¢ per KWH for the first 50 KWH used per month per KW of billing demand.

1.0¢ per KWH for all remaining KWH used per month.

Determination of Billing Demand:

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the consumer for any period fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter and adjusted for power factor as provided below.

Power Factor Adjustment:

The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. The Cooperative reserves the right to measure such power factor at any time. Should such measurements indicate that the power factor at the time of his maximum demand is less than 85%, the demand for billing purposes shall be the demand as indicated or recorded by the demand meter multiplied by 85% and divided by the present power factor.

Fuel Cost Adjustment Charges:

In case the rate under which the Cooperative purchases power at wholesale is adjusted in accordance with a fuel cost adjustment provision in the Cooperative's wholesale power contract, the foregoing energy charges shall be adjusted each month by the same amount per KWH as the fuel cost adjustment per KWH in the Cooperative's wholesale power bill for the next preceding month.

CLASSIFICATION OF SERVICE

Large Power Service - Schedule 4A.

RATE PER UNIT

Minimum Monthly Charge:

The minimum monthly charge shall be the highest one of the following charges as determined for the consumer in question:

- (1) The minimum monthly charge specified in the contract for service.
- (2) A charge of \$0.75 per KVA of installed transformer capacity.
- (3) A charge of \$25.00

Minimum Annual Charge for Seasonal Service:

Consumers requiring service only during certain seasons not exceeding 9 months per year may guarantee a minimum annual charge, in which case there shall be no minimum monthly charge. The minimum annual charge shall be sufficient to assure adequate compensation for the facilities installed to serve the Consumer, and in no event shall it be less than \$9.00 per kva of installed transformer capacity, or \$300, whichever is greater.

Service Provisions:

1. Delivery Point. If service is furnished at secondary voltage the delivery point shall be the metering point unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines and other electric equipment on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the Consumer.

If service is furnished at the Cooperative's primary line voltage the delivery point shall be the point of attachment of the Cooperative's primary line to Consumer's transformer structure unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines and other electric equipment (except metering equipment) on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the Consumer.

2. Lighting. Both power and lighting shall be billed at the foregoing rate. If a separate meter is required for the lighting circuit, the registrations of the two meters shall be added to obtain the total kilowatt hours used and the registrations, of the two demand meters, shall be added to obtain the total kilowatt demand for billing purposes.

3. Primary Service: If service is furnished at primary distribution voltage, a discount of \$0.15 per kw of billing demand shall apply.

Terms of Payment:

The above rates are net, the gross rates being 5% higher on the first \$25.00 and 2% higher on the remainder of the bill. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within fifteen (15) days from the date of the bill, the gross rates shall apply.
