GENERAL CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

APPLICABILITY:

The following shall be applied to rate Schedule D.

DELIVERY POINT:

Unless otherwise specified in the service contract, the delivery point shall be the metering point when service is furnished at secondary voltage, or the point of attachment of the Seller's primary line to the consumer's transformer structure if service is furnished at primary line voltage. All wiring, pole lines and other equipment (except metering equipment) on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the consumer.

SEASONAL SERVICE:

Consumers requiring service only during certain seasons of the year who are served under a contract defining the season of service and the minimum annual charge shall be served in accordance with the applicable rate schedule for the class of service except that there shall be no minimum monthly charge. There shall be a minimum annual charge sufficient to assure adequate compensation for the facilities installed to serve the consumer, and in no case less than 12 times the minimum monthly charge determined in accordance with the applicable rate schedule.

TEMPORARY SERVICE:

Temporary service shall be in accordance with the applicable rate schedule for the class of service except that the consumer shall pay in addition to the specified rate and charges the total cost of connecting and disconnecting service less the value of materials returned to stock. An advance deposit may be required of the full amount of the estimated bill for service including the cost of connection and disconnection.

PRIMARY SERVICE:

If service is furnished at the Seller's primary distribution voltage, a discount shall apply to the charges specified in the applicable rate schedule. The Seller may meter at secondary voltage and adjust to primary metering by adding the estimated transformer losses to the metered kilowatt-hours and kilowatts. The discount for primary service shall be 10% of the total bill.

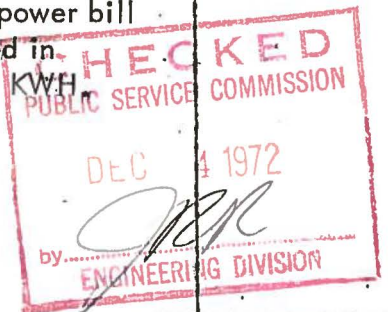

In case the rate under which the Seller purchased power at wholesale is adjusted in accordance with the Fuel Clause provision in the Sellers Wholesale Power Contract with its wholesale power supplier, the foregoing energy charges shall be adjusted each month by an amount per KWH equal to 1.10 times the fuel cost adjustment per KWH or each fraction thereof, in the Sellers wholesale power bill for the next preceding month. The Fuel Adjustment for billings rendered in December, 1972, January and February, 1973 will be 2.4024 mills per KWH.
