For consumers requiring more than 5,000 KVA of transformer capacity, the minimum monthly charge shall be increased by 75 cents for each KVA or fraction thereof required above 5,000 KVA. Where it is necessary to extend or reinforce facilities in excess of standard service facilities, the minimum monthly charge may be increased to assure adequate compensation for the added facilities at $1\frac{1}{2}$ percent per month of the total cost of the excess facilities as a facilities charge for which no power and energy would be delivered.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

Compensating starting equipment may be required for all motors when specified by the Seller because of power line characteristics.

DELIVERY POINT:

Unless other wise specified in the service contract, the delivery point shall be the connection between conductors furnished and installed by the Seller and the conductors furnished and installed by the Consumer. All wiring, pole lines, and other equipment (except metering equipment) on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the Consumer.
