The payment to be made by the applicant shall be determined from total footage of single phase primary, secondary and service conductor to be installed at an average per foot cost differential in accordance with the 1989 Average Cost Differential filed herewith (T) as Exhibit "A", which 1989 Average Cost Differential (T) shall be updated annually. (Three wire secondary and service conductor runs shall be considered as one conductor, i.e. triplex). The average cost differential per foot, as stated, is representative of construction in soil free of rock, shale, or other impairments which increase cost of construction. Where rock, shale or other impairments are anticipated or encountered in construction, the actual increased cost of trenching and backfilling shall be borne by the applicant.

- (f) The applicant may be required to deposit the entire estimated cost of the extension. If this is done, the amount deposited in excess of the normal charge for the underground extensions, as provided in paragraph "e" above, shall be refunded to the applicant over a ten (10) year period as provided by the Public Service Commission
- (g) The applicant may be required to perform all necessary trenching and backfilling in accordance with the Cooperative's specifications. The Cooperative shall then credit the applicant's cost in an amount equal to the Cooperative's normal cost for trenching and backfilling.

The Cooperative shall furnish, install and maintain the service lateral to the Applicant's meter base (which normally will be at the corner of the building nearest the point to be served) except that the applicant shall furnish and install proper size conduit from the meter base to eighteen (18) inches below ground level.

bill for the period during which the meter error is known to have existed, shall be recomputed and the account adjusted on the basis of the test. In the event the period during which the meter error existed is unknown, then the customer's bill shall be recomputed for one-half (1/2) of the elapsed time since the last previous test but in no case to exceed twelve months. If the meter is found upon test to register fast and if time for periodic test has overrun to the extent that one-half (1/2) of the time elapsed since the last previous test exceed twelve months, the refund shall be for the twelve months in addition a like refund for those months exceeding the periodic test period. There shall be no back billing for meters showing a slow error.

H . RECONNECTION OF EXISTING SERVICE:

The Cooperative shall charge a ten dollar (\$10.00) reconnect fee to partially offset the cost of reconnection in the following instances:

- The member desires to be disconnected and reconnected within 1. a one (1) year period such as for vacations, temporary absence, etc.
- The member desires an existing service reconnected for a (2. period of less than one (1) year.

- The Cooperative will mail a billing card monthly to each 1. customer or member on or about the bill/read date of each month for each cycle. Such card shall show the previous and present meter readings, KWH's used, gross charges, net charges, applicable rate schedule and taxes. The card shall also request the consumer to read his meter upon receipt of billing card and space for this information shall be provided on the card. The card shall be perforated to allow one portion to be returned to the office and one portion to remain with the consumer as a receipt and/or record.
- The consumer or member is requested to pay the net bill by 2. fourteen (14) days of date the bill is mailed by the Cooperative, together with the current months meter reading.
 - Mail Payments: (a) (T) Checks, money orders, VISA or MasterCard and not cash should be used by the consumer Rubent making coayments by mail. The cancelled check, money order, VISA or MasterCard receipt, shall serve as the customers receipt.
 - APR 1 5 1980 (b) Office Payments: Payments received at the office shall be receipted on the consumer's portion of the birling study and returned to the consumer as a receipt.
 - Night Depository: (c) A night depository is provided by the Cooperative for payment after hours for the convenience of the consumer. Checks, or money orders should be used since the

D. CASH DEPOSITS:

The Cooperative may require at any time from any consumer or prospective consumer, a cash deposit intended to guarantee payment of current bills. Such required deposit shall not exceed the a amount of any estimated two-twelfths (2/12) annual bill of such customer. At the option of the Cooperative, the cash deposit may be returned to the consumer after twelve (12) months or may be (T) applied against any unpaid billing. Interest shall be paid as prescribed by the Public Service Commission of Kentucky on such deposits. Any balance remaining after final billing shall be returned to the consumer.

E. RETURNED CHECKS:

- 1. Checks returned to the Cooperative by the bank which are marked "insufficient funds", "no account", etc. will be not regarded as payment. Postdated checks will not be accepted by the Cooperative as payment of any account.
- 2. Upon receiving a returned check from the bank, a letter shall be prepared and mailed to the consumer stating that such check or checks have been returned to the Cooperative, and that the account is still due and payable in addition to a \$5.00 charge for handling the returned check. If reimbursement is made by the consumer for such check prior to the delinquent date, then the net charge will prevail. However, if reimbursement by the consumer to the Cooperative is made following the delinquent date, the gross charges shall apply.
- Should the bank make a charge for returning such checks, these costs shall be charged (passed on) to the consumer.

- K. BUDGET BILLING:

The Cooperative has established a budget billing plan, and such billing plan is available to any residential consumer by:

- 1. Executing a Budget Billing Plan Agreement which provides for the following:

 - (a) Agreeing to all rules, regulations and parties of the Cooperative.
 - (b) Agreeing to a budget payment monthly together Nwith a current meter reading by the due date:
- Budget billing will be established once each year, November thru September, with October as the Annual Adjustment Month.
- 3. The agreement may be cancelled by either party upon 30 days notice or will automatically cancel upon failure to make a scheduled payment.
- Upon disconnection because of failure to pay budgeted amount, the entire bill becomes due and payable before service is reconnected.
