TARIFF O. L. (Outdoor Lighting)

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE.

Available for outdoor lighting to individual customers located outside areas covered by municipal street lighting systems.

This Tariff is made available for experimental purposes to determine the usefulness of this type of service to the customers described above. It is available only for service contracted for before January 1, 1962.

RATE.

(T)

For each 2500 lumens overhead lamp with diffuser and an unsweep arm not over 6 feet in length controlled by photoelectric relay where service is supplied from the existing pole and secondary facilities of company................\$3.00 per lamp per month

When new facilities are to be installed by the company, the customer will in addition to the above monthly charge, pay in advance the installation cost for the new overhead facilities extending from the nearest or most suitable pole of the company to the point designated by the customer for the installation of said lamp.

PAYMENT.

Bills are due and payable at the main or branch offices of the company within 15 days of the mailing date.

TERM OF CONTRACT.

For residential or farm customers-1 year.

For commercial or general service customers—3 years.

HOURS OF LIGHTING.

All lamps shall burn from one-half hour after sunset until one-half hour before sunrise, every night and all night, burning approximately 4,000 hours per annum.

OWNERSHIP OF FACILITIES.

All facilities necessary for service including fixtures, controls, poles, transformers, secondaries, lamps and other appurtenances shall be owned and maintained by the company. All service and necessary maintenance will be performed only during the regular scheduled working hours of the company.

The company shall be allowed 48 hours after notification by the customer to replace all burned-out lamps.

The Company shall have the option of rendering monthly or bimonthly bills
