RE: AN EXAMINATION OF THE APPLICATION OF THE FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE OF LOUISVILLE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY FROM NOVEMBER 1, 2014 THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2016 – CASE NO. 2017-00004

Dear Mr. Horrell:


As a result of an Order issued on July 31, 2017 in Louisville Gas and Electric Company’s (“LG&E”) Fuel Adjustment Clause (“FAC”) Review in Case No. 2017-00004, the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) authorized a roll-in of a portion of the current FAC factor into existing base rates, including the rates contained in the power contract dated October 10, 1961, between LG&E and Louisville Water Company. The roll-in results in a decrease in energy charges and the monthly FAC factor effective with service rendered on and after September 1, 2017.

The rates approved by the Commission are set forth below:

Demand Charge: \$12.89 per kW of billing demand per month

Energy Charge: \$ 0.03560 per kWh

Fuel Clause: This special contract is subject to the provisions of the Fuel Adjustment Clause found in LG&E’s P.S.C. Electric No. 11, Sheet No. 85. (See attached.)
