

EXHIBIT GOOCH FRANCHISE

EXHIBIT NO. 1

An Ordinance in regard to the Gooch Electric Light
Co.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LOUISVILLE, That

Upon the terms and subject to the provisions herein set
forth, there shall be, and is hereby granted to the Gooch
Electric Co., its successors and assigns, the right to erect
and maintain poles along the public ways of said City, and
the right to place and maintain on said poles, fixtures, wires
and all necessary appliances for the transmission of power
and light by the aid of electricity.

It is provided that said poles shall not be less than
thirty feet in length, at least seven inches in diameter at
the top, reasonably straight, dressed and painted, and set in
the ground securely and well; that said poles, wires, fixtures
and appliances, as regards the dimensions that shall be ob-
served and the material that shall be used, as well as the
workmanship, shall be subject to the approval of the City En-
gineer and Inspector of Electric Lights and Wires, or such
person or persons as may hereafter be appointed to regulate
the erection and operation of electric wires in the City
of Louisville; that said poles or wires or any of them shall
be removed at the direction of the General Council of the
City of Louisville within six months after proper notification,
provided that no such removal shall be ordered unless all
electric lighting companies or firms shall also be ordered
to remove their overhead wires, and in case this company or
its successors or assigns is ordered to remove them, said

company or processors or assigns shall have the right to use the streets, sidewalks and alleys of the City of Louisville for the purpose of putting its wires and conduits or pipes underground. And it shall be the duty of said company to restore the street, alley or sidewalk to as good a condition as before, upon putting down said conduits, pipes or wires, bond being executed and delivered to perform said condition in the sum of \$5,000.00; that other persons or companies having the right to erect wires in the City of Louisville, may acquire privileges to attach their wires to said poles or any of them upon the payment to said Gooch Electric Co. of a reasonable compensation, provided however, that such privileges shall not be granted except upon the approval of the City Engineer and Inspector of Electric Lights and Wires, and that wires so erected shall be subject to all the provisions and requirements of this ordinance, and the construction shall be done as not to interfere with any fire-alarm or police signal service that may be now or hereafter erected in said city.

The resolution heretofore passed and approved May 12th, 1890 granting to the Gooch Electric Company, the right to erect and maintain poles, wires, etc. on the street, be and is hereby repealed.
