Schedule 6-C - Continued

Minimum Annual Charge for Seasonal Service:

Consumers requiring service only during certain seasons not exceeding nine months per year may guarantee a minimum annual charge, in which case there shall be no minimum monthly charge. The minimum annual charge shall be sufficient to assure adequate compensation for the facilities installed to serve the customer, and in no event shall be less than twelve times the monthly minimum as set forth in Rate Schedule 6-C.

Terms of Payment:

The above rates are net, the gross rates being ten percent (10%) higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within ten (10) days from the due date, the gross rates shall apply.

Special Terms and Conditions:

Service under this schedule is subject to the Special Terms and Conditions set forth herein. Special Terms and Conditions Relating to the Application of Schedule 6-C, Schools and Churches.

Multiple Units:

Service supplied under rate Schedule 6-C is based on service to a single unit at one delivery point through one single meter. Where premises consist of two or more units, Schedule 6-C may be applied only if separate circuits are provided without cost to the Distributor. If it is not practical to ED provide for metering of each unit, the entire premises will to MMISSION be served under the appropriate commercial rate
