of a unit; the Cooperative will extend its secondary conductor one span, not to exceed 150 feet, and install an additional pole for the support of such unit and the member shall pay an additional charge of \$0.25 per pole per month per pole installed. If more than one pole is required, the member agreeb to pay the actual cost of construction beyond the first pole and first 150 feet.

- 2. All lighting units, poles and conductors installed in accordance herewith shall be the property of the Cooperative and Cooperative shall have access to the same for maintenance. inspection and all other proper purposes. Cooperative shall have the right to make other attachments to the poles and to further extend the conductors installed in accordance herewith when necessary for the further extension of its electric service. Lighting units will be removed at the request of the member on 30 days notice upon the anniversary date of the signed agreement in any year. The minimum such period shall be one year; and shall continue from month to month thereafter until terminated by either party giving 30 days notice to the other, for which the member agrees to pay the rates as set forth herein.
- When it becomes necessary to install the lighting unit on the load side of the member's meter, at the member's request, the KWH consumption will be included in the regular meter reading, and billed in the regular monthly electric bill. In which case the rental charge only for the specific unit or units installed, including pole rental, if any, will be added to the member's monthly bill.
- 4. This schedule covers service from overhead circuits only, with installation on wood poles; provided however, that when feasible, flood lights served hereunder may be attached to existing metal street lighting standards supplied from overhead or underground circuits.
