COMMERCIAL, SMALL POWER, SINGLE PHASE AND THREE PHASE SERVICE

APPLICABLE: Entire Service Area

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE: Available to commercial consumers and small power loads requiring transformers capacity of 50 KVA or less, single phase and commercial consumers requiring three phase service with less than 50 KVA of total transformer capacity subject to the established rules and regulations of the Cooperative.

TYPE OF SERVICE: Single phase 120/240 volts and three phase where available at available voltages.

RATES PER MONTH:

First	40 KWH per month or less	\$6.49	(Minimum Bill)
Next	60 KWH per month	.10634	net per KWH
Next	2,900 KWH per month	.06255	net per KWH
Over	3,000 KWH per month	.05143	net per KWH

FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE: The above rate may be increased or decreased by an amount per KWH equal to the fuel adjustment amount per KWH as billed by the Wholesale Power Supplier plus an allowance for line losses. The allowance for line losses will not exceed 10% and is based on a twelve month moving average of such losses.

MINIMUM CHARGE: The minimum monthly charge for single phase service shall be \$6.49.

<p>SCHEDULE 2 (Cont'd.)</p> <p>The minimum monthly charge for three phase service shall be computed on a basis of 1 1/2 percent of the additional investment, which includes the additional cost of the transformers. The minimum bill will be effective for a period of five (5) years from the date on which service commences. After this period the minimum monthly charge as specified in the contract for service shall be effective.</p> <p><u>SPECIAL RULES FOR SINGLE PHASE:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Applications for commercial single phase service shall be required to sign a five (5) year contract to pay not less than the minimum bill for five (5) years. Prior written approval must be obtained from the Cooperative before installation of any motor in excess of 10 H.P. single phase. <p><u>SPECIAL RULES FOR THREE PHASE SERVICE:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The consumer must give satisfactory assurance by means of a written agreement as to the character, amount and duration of the business and complete a five (5) year contract. The consumer will guarantee the computed minimum monthly bill for five (5) years. On three phase installations, all motors 10 H.P. and larger must be three phase. 	<p>(T)</p>
