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POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT

The Consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Power factor may be measured at any time. Should such measurements indicate that the power factor at the time of his maximum demand is less than 85%, the demand for billing purposes shall be the demand as indicated or recorded by the demand meter multiplied by 85% and divided by the per cent power factor.

FUEL COST ADJUSTMENT

In case the rate under which the Seller purchases power at wholesale is adjusted in accordance with a fuel cost adjustment provision in Seller's wholesale power contract, the foregoing energy charges shall be adjusted each month by the same amount per KWHR as the fuel cost adjustment per KWHR in Seller's wholesale power bill for the next preceding month.

MINIMUM CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge shall be the highest one of the following charges:

- (a) The minimum monthly charge as specified in the contract for service.
- (b) A charge of \$0.75 per KVA per month of contract capacity.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

An "Agreement for Purchase of Power" shall be executed by the Consumer for service under this schedule.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

The electric service furnished under this schedule will be 60 cycle, alternating current and at available nominal voltage.

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

<p><u>SPECIAL PROVISIONS</u></p> <p>1. <u>Delivery Point.</u> If service is furnished at secondary voltage, the delivery point shall be the metering point unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines and other electric equipment on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the Consumer.</p> <p>If service is furnished at Seller's primary line voltage, the delivery point shall be the point of attachment of Seller's primary line to Consumer's transformer structure unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines and other electrical equipment (except metering equipment) on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the Consumer.</p> <p>2. <u>Lighting.</u> Both power and lighting shall be billed at the foregoing rate.</p> <p>3. <u>Primary Service.</u> If service is furnished at 7200/12470 volts or above, a discount of 5% shall apply to the Demand and Energy charges.</p> <p>The Seller shall have the option of metering at secondary voltage.</p>			
<p><u>TERMS OF PAYMENT</u></p> <p>All of the above rates are net, the gross rates being five per cent (5%) higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within fifteen days from the date of the bill, the gross rate shall apply.</p>			
			

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
