CLASSIFICATION OF SERVICE

TEMPORARY SERVICE - RATE 7

RATE PER UNIT

AVAILABILITY:

Available in all territories along the lines of the Cooperative when the termination of service under this schedule will be followed by a permanent installation of service under one or more of the Cooperative's established rate schedules. Service is available primarily for building contractors for the construction of buildings which when completed will be served from the lines constructed to render service under this schedule.

TYPE OF SERVICE:

Single-phase, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltage.

RATE:

First 400 KWH or less 5.0¢ per KWH
All over 400 KWH 2.5¢ per KWH

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MINIMUM CHARGE:

The minimum charge under the above rate shall be \$20.00 for a ninety (90) day period payable in advance with the application for service. Payment of the minimum charge shall entitle the consumer in all cases to the use of the number of kilowatt-hours corresponding to the minimum charge in accordance with the foregoing rate. Transformer capacity under the above rate shall be limited to a maximum of 10-KVA.

CLASSIFICATION OF SERVICE

TEMPORARY SERVICE - RATE 7

RATE PER UNIT

TERM:

Service under this schedule shall be for a period of ninety (90) days. Contracts may be renewed for as many additional ninety (90) day periods as requested by the consumer, provided however, the minimum charge of \$20.00 shall be paid in advance of each renewal.

SPECIAL RULES:

- (a) Written application required.
- (b) The contractor must install a minimum 60 amp, 240 volt load center, and the necessary fuse protection and equipment to protect the Cooperative's transformers from overloads. (The above installation must conform to the National Electric Safety Code).

FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE:

The above rate may be increased by an amount per KWH equal to 1.10 times the fuel adjustment per KWH in excess of 1.5 mills per KWH as billed by the wholesale supplier in the preceding month. The adjustment shall be applied to the nearest 0.1 mill per KWH.
