TEMPORARY SERVICE

Availability

Available in all territories along the lines of the cooperative when the termination of service under this schedule will be followed by a permanent installation of service under one or more of the cooperatives established rate schedules. Service is available primarily for building contractors for the construction of buildings which when completed will be served from the lines constructed to render service under this schedule.

Type of Service

Single-phase, 60 cycle, at available secondary voltage.

Rate

First 200 kwh or less	5.0¢ per kwh
All over 200 kwh	2.5¢ per kwh

**PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION**

Minimum Charge

The minimum charge under the above rate shall be \$10.00 for a sixty day period payable in advance with the application for service. Payment of the minimum charge shall entitle the consumer in all cases to the use of the number of kilowatt-hours corresponding to the minimum charge in accordance with the foregoing rate. Transformer capacity under the above rate shall be limited to 5 kva.

**CANCELED SEPT. 18 1970**

Term

Service under this schedule shall be for a period of sixty days. Contracts may be renewed for as many additional sixty day periods as requested by the consumer provided, however, the minimum charge of \$10.00 shall be paid in advance of each renewal.

Special Rules

- (a) Written application required.
- (b) The consumer must install the necessary fuse protection equipment to protect the cooperative's transformers from overloads.
