An additional charge of \$2 per year will be added to the total charge as determined above for each additional pole required, unless the village pays the installed cost of such additional poles.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

1. Street-lighting equipment including lamps, fixtures, and the necessary street-lighting circuits, transformers and additional guys and fittings will be furnished, installed and maintained at no cost to the user except for the rates as set out in this schedule. Where extensions of primary line are required, the total cost of such construction shall be paid by the village.
2. Service will be furnished for future additional lamps in accordance with the above charges. The average spacing between lamps shall be recomputed to include the additional lamps.
