Applicable: Consumers located in the Counties of Pulaski, Wayne, Clinton (including the City of Albany), McCreary and Russell, and consumers located in parts of the Counties of Casey, Lincoln, Rockcastle, Adair, Cumberland and Laurel in Ky.

Availability of Service: Available to consumers of the Cooperative for all farm and home uses subject to its established rules and regulations. The capacity of individual motors served under this schedule may not exceed 10 horsepower.

Type of Service: Single-phase, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltage.

<u>Rates:</u>	First	30 kwh per month @	\$2.35 (Minimum)
	Next	50 kwh per month @	4.5¢ per kwh
	Next	120 kwh per month @	2.5¢ per kwh
	Next	300 kwh per month @	1.1¢ per kwh

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Minimum Charge: The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$2.35 where 3 kva or less of transformer capacity is required (except the City of Albany in Clinton County in which the minimum monthly charge shall be \$1.50 for 19 kwh and 7.7¢ for the next 11 kwh, with all remaining kwh the same as the above residential rate). For consumers requiring more than 3 kva of transformer capacity, the minimum monthly charge shall be increased at the rate of 75¢ for each additional kva or fraction thereof required. Payment of the minimum charge shall entitle the consumer in all cases to the use of the number of kilowatt hours corresponding to the minimum charge in accordance with the foregoing rate.

Terms of Payment: The above rates are net.
