AGREEMENT FOR ELECTRIC SERVICE

AGREEMENT made
RURAL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION (herinafter called the "Seller"),
and GREENWOOD LAND & MINING CO. (herinafter called the "Consumer") a
Corporation
(Corporation, Partnership or Individual)
The Seller shall sell and deliver to the Consumer, and the Consumer shall
purchase all of the electric power and energy which the Consumer may need at this
location up to 2,000 KVA capacity, upon the following terms:
1. SERVICE CHARACTERISTICS
a. Service hereunder shall be alternating current, 3 Phase,
$\frac{12,470}{7,200}$ volts.
b. The Consumer shall not use the electric power and energy furnished
hereunder as an auxiliary or supplement to any other source of
power and shall not sell electric power and energy purchased
hereunder.
c. In the event the operation of the Copymer strvice commission
OF KENTUCKY of the Seller interfere with the supply of electrical varient to the
remaining consumers of the Seller, the Consumer 22 1507 to the
termination of service. PURSUANT TO 807 KAR 61011,
2. PAYMENT BY
a. The Consumer shall pay the Seller for service hereunder at the rates
and upon the terms and conditions set forth in the Special Rate
attached and Approved by the Kentucky Public Service Commission not
withstanding any provision of the Rate and irrespective of Consumer's
requirements for or use of electric power and energy, the Consumer
shall pay to the Seller the minimum bill as set forth in the stated
Rate Schedule, but in any case it shall not be less than \$1,100.00

per month for service or for having service available hereunder during

the term hereof.

- b. The initial billing period shall start when Consumer begins using electric power and energy, or whenever that service is made available by the Seller, whichever shall occur first.
- Seller in Somerset or any Branch Office of the Seller in the State of Kentucky. Such payments shall be due each month as stated on the invoice, for service furnished during the preceding monthly billing period. If the Consumer shall fail to make any such payment within the period such payment is due, the Seller may discontinue service Ten(10)to the Consumer upon giving five (5) days written notice to the Consumer of its intention to do so, provided, however, that such discontinuance of service shall not relieve the Consumer of any of its obligations under this Agreement.
- d. The Consumer agrees that if, at any time, the rate is changed and approved by the Kentucky Public Service Commission or any other regulatory body having jurisdiction, the Seller may make the corresponding modification in the rate for service hereunder.

MEMBERSHIP

The Consumer shall become a member of the Seller, shall pay the membership

4. CONTINUITY OF SERVICE

The Seller shall use reasonable diligence to provide a constant and uninterrupted supply of electric power and energy hereunder. If the supply of
electric power and energy shall fail or be interrupted, or become defective
through an act of God, Governmental authority, action of the elements, public
enemy, accident, strikes, labor trouble, required maintenance work, inability
to secure right-of-way, or any other cause beyond the reasonable control of

Seller, the Seller shall not be liable therefore or for damages caused thereby.

5. RIGHT OF WAY

Duly authorized representatives of the Seller shall be permitted to enter the Consumer's premises at all reasonable times. The Consumer agrees to grant the Seller right of-way to install and maintain electric lines and equipment upon the Consumers property.

6. TERM

This Agreement shall become effective on the date first above written and shall remain in effect until _5__years following the start of the initial billing period and thereafter until terminated by either party giving to the other 30 days notice in writing.

7. ADVANCE FOR CONSTRUCTION

The Consumer shall advance with the Seller the sum of \$ None on account of the cost of facilities required to make service available to the Consumer on or before commencement of construction of such facilities.

Such advance shall be returnable to the Consumer in the form of a credit on each bill for service in the amount of N.A. percent of the bill (demand and energy portion - excluding taxes and any other publication of KENTUCKY which credits shall continue until they total \$ N.A.
