<p>PART 2 (for loads requiring 50 KVA and above installed transformer capacity)</p> <p>Customer Charge: \$31.85 per meter per month</p> <p>Demand Charge: 4.13 per KW or billing demand</p> <p>Energy Charges:</p> <p>All KWH per month .03872</p> <p>DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND</p> <p>The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the consumer for any period of fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter and adjusted for power factor as provided below.</p> <p>POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT</p> <p>The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. The measured demand will be adjusted to correct for consumers with 50 KW or more of measured demand to correct for average power factors lower than 85 per cent. Such adjustments will be made by increasing the measured demand 1 percent for each 1 percent by which the average power factor is less than 85 percent lagging.</p> <p>FUEL ADJUSTMENT CHARGE</p> <p>All rates are applicable to the Fuel Adjustment Clause and may be increased or decreased by an amount per KWH equal to the fuel adjustment amount per KWH as billed by the Wholesale Power Supplier plus an allowance for line losses. The allowance for line losses will not exceed 10% and is based on a twelve-month moving average of such losses.
