reduce its energy costs, extreme adverse consequences are likely to result, including declines in employment and potential plant shutdowns.

(7) NSA is currently transporting all of its natural gas requirements on Western Kentucky Gas Company's (Western) system.

NSA has a gas transmission line currently in place interconnecting (8) its manufacturing facilities in Hancock County, Kentucky with the interstate pipeline of Texas Gas Transmission Corporation. NSA accordingly has in place the facilities necessary to effectuate a complete physical by-pass of Western's system. The estimated cost of refurbishing this line is \$100,000.

NSA has advised Western that unless Western reduces its (9) transportation rate for interruptible service by at least the sum of 31.003¢ per mcf transportation, NSA will refurbish its aforesaid existing line and will by-pass Western's system, it having been determined by NSA that such by-pass would be economically feasible and advantageous to NSA.

(10) Further the Affiant saith not.
