RULES AND REGULATIONS

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS WITH REFERENCE TO RATE SCHEDULES

1. Unless otherwise specified, a domestic, commercial or industrial consumer shall be interpreted to mean a customer served through an individual meter.
2. A multiple unit dwelling shall be interpreted to mean two or more consumers or dwelling units, such as apartments, trailers or mobile homes within a trailer park.
3. A master meter shall be interpreted to mean one meter servicing a trailer or mobile home park or a multiple unit dwelling; the Company reserves the right to charge a minimum monthly rate per mobile home or trailer or individual consumer within a multiple unit dwelling served through a master meter.
4. Anytime a master meter is used for rendering service, the Company shall require the execution of a service agreement in writing, which agreement among other things, shall specify the number of customers served through such master meter.
5. "MCF" is defined as 1,000 cubic feet at the measurement base.
6. Measurement Base: The unit of measurement shall be a MCF at a pressure base of 14.76 psia, a temperature of 60°F. and 0.6 specific gravity, having approximately 1,000 B. T. U. content per cubic foot.
7. "Service Area" is defined as any area supplied from one connection with the Company's supplier, i.e., Nicholasville-Wilmore is one service area as one connection from Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company supplies both communities.
8. All rates of the Company are subject to Purchased Gas Adjustment Clause as approved by the Public Service Commission.
9. Terms of payment: All bills are due and payable in ten (10) days.
10. Delinquent Bill Charge: A charge of \$2.60 will be made to collect a delinquent bill.
11. Reconnection Charge: Reconnection charge will be \$9.00.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS WITH REFERENCE TO RATE SCHEDULES

- 13. The Rules, Regulations and Orders of the Public Service Commission and of the Company shall apply to all rate schedules and all contracts thereunder.
- 14. Special Provisions: None unless otherwise specified under a specific rate schedule.
- 15. DEFINITIONS:

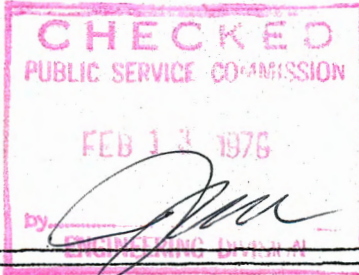
Residential: Service to customers which consists of direct natural gas usage in a residential dwelling for space heating, air conditioning, cooking, water heating and other residential uses.

Commercial: Service to customers engaged primarily in the sale of goods or services including institutions and local and federal government agencies for uses other than those involving manufacturing or electric power generation.

- (a) Small Commercial - Usage of up to 50 MCF per day.
- (b) Large Commercial - Usage of 50 MCF or more per day.

Industrial: Service to customers engaged primarily in a process which creates or changes raw or unfinished materials into another form or product including the generation of electric power.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

**PURCHASED GAS ADJUSTMENT
APPLICABLE TO ALL RATE SCHEDULES**

The rates authorized herein are based upon the wholesale cost of gas to the Applicant as computed upon rates of its wholesale suppliers then currently in effect under Federal Power Commission tariffs for interstate business or under wholesale tariffs of this Commission. For the purpose of this purchased gas adjustment clause, these rates shall be considered as the base rate for purchased gas. In the event there is an increase in this base rate, the Applicant shall within thirty days from the time it receives notice of the proposed change file with this Commission the following information:

- (1) A copy of the Federal Power Commission tariff or wholesale tariff at this Commission effecting the change in the base rate and a statement relative to the effective date of such proposed change.
- (2) A statement setting out the details of gas purchased under the provision of the base rate for the previous twelve months showing billing under the base rate and under the proposed revised rate applicable to this service.
- (3) A balance sheet as of the end of the latest twelve months period and a statement of operating expenses and revenues in the same detail as reported to this Commission in the Utility's Annual Report.
- (4) Such other information as this Commission may request for a proper determination of the purchased gas adjustment.

Upon receipt of this information this Commission will review the effect of the revised rate on the operation of the Applicant and will prior to the effective date of the revised base rate, but not less than thirty days from the date of the filing of the above prescribed information issue its Order setting out the purchased gas adjustment that the Utility shall apply to its rates.

In the event there is a decrease in purchased gas costs or refund, the Applicant shall file the information required in 1, 2 and 4 above.

**PURCHASED GAS ADJUSTMENT
APPLICABLE TO ALL RATE SCHEDULES**

Upon receipt of this information, the Commission shall review the proposed reductions and within thirty days from receipt of the information required, issue its Order setting out the proper refund and/or the revised rates.

The maximum amount of the adjustment so prescribed shall not produce revenue adjustments based upon the actual preceding twelve months period, greater than the difference between the purchased gas billed at the then existing rates and the purchased gas billed at the revised rate.

On and after the effective date of this rate schedule, if any increase or decrease is made in the rate at which Company's gas suppliers sell gas to Company, the unit charges of the aforesaid rate schedule shall be increased or decreased by a Purchased Gas Adjustment determined as follows:

(1) Gas purchases by the Company under supplier's applicable rate schedule during a period of twelve calendar months ending within two months preceding the month of the effective date of the supplier's rate change will be determined. Such purchases shall be priced:

(a) At the Base Supplier Rate

(b) At the New Supplier Rate

(2) The difference between the amounts so determined shall be divided by the number of cubic feet of gas sold by Company during the said twelve-month period. The unit charge or credit so determined, expressed in cents per cubic feet, shall be the Purchased Gas Adjustment.

(3) The new supplier rate shall be come the Base Supplier Rate to be used in measuring the effect of any subsequent supplier rate change. Each such subsequent change shall be treated in the same manner as set forth above for the establishment of a new Purchased Gas Adjustment and for the establishment of a new Base Supplier Rate.

**PURCHASED GAS ADJUSTMENT
APPLICABLE TO ALL RATE SCHEDULES**

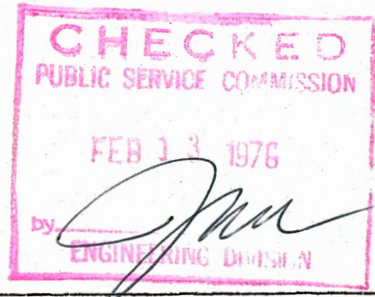
In the event that the Company receives from its supplier a refund of amounts paid to such supplier in respect of a prior period, the Company will apply to the Commission for authority and upon receipt thereof make adjustments on the amounts charged to its customers under this provision, as follows:

(1) The "Refundable Amount" shall be the amount received by the Company as a refund. Such Refundable Amount shall be divided by the number of cubic feet of gas that Company estimates it will sell to its customers during the four-month period commencing with the first day of the month following receipt of the refund, thus determining a "Refund Factor".

(2) Effective with meter readings taken on and after the first day of the second month following receipt of the refund, the Company will reduce by the Refund Factor so determined any Purchased Gas Adjustment that would otherwise be applicable during such period. Provided, however, that the period of reduced Purchased Gas Adjustment will be adjusted, if necessary, in order to refund as nearly as possible the Refundable Amount.

(3) In the event of any large or unusual refunds, the Company may apply to the Public Service Commission of Kentucky for the right to depart from the refund procedure herein set forth.

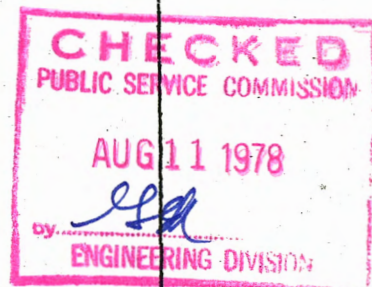

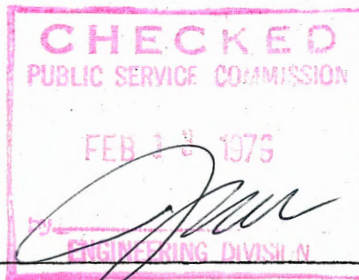
