Gentlemen:

The gas service contract with your company contains a provision that during the seven (7) month summer period, April 1 through October 31, the rate is  $40\phi$  per MCF plus escalation for the first 50,000 MCF.

Conditions are such that during the period from April 1, 1962, through October 31, 1962, we are able to make a reduction in the rate for summer off-peak gas to  $38\phi$  per ACF plus escalation for the first 50,000 MCF.

If the above modification is agreeable to you, will you please sign this original copy and return it to us. When the return copy of this letter is received by us, it will be considered as a modification of the contract dated February 14, 1961, insofar as applicable for the period April 1, 1962, through October 31, 1962.
