Re: Rate for summer and winter off-peak gas from April 1, 1960 through March 31, 1961

Gentlemen:

The gas service contract with your Company contains a provision that during the seven (7) months summer period, April 1 through October 31, the rate is  $40^{\circ}$  per MCF plus escalation for the first 50,000 MCF, and  $35^{\circ}$  per MCF plus escalation for all additional volumes. It also provides that during the five (5) months winter period, November 1 through March 31, that the rate is  $47^{\circ}$  per MCF plus escalation for the first 50,000 MCF per month, and  $45^{\circ}$  per MCF plus escalation for all additional volumes.

Conditions are such that for the period from April 1, 1960 through October 31, 1960, we are able to make a reduction in the rates for summer off-peak gas to  $38\phi$  per MCF plus escalation for the first 50,000 MCF. Also, we will be able to make a reduction in the rate for the winter period, November 1, 1960 through March 31, 1961 to  $45\phi$  per MCF plus escalation for the first 50,000 MCF, and to  $43\phi$  per MCF plus escalation for all additional volumes.

If the above modification is agreeable to you, will you please sign this original copy and return it to us. When the returned copy of this letter is received by us, it will be considered as a modification of the contract dated (March 2.3) (Sinsofar as applicable for the period April 1, 1960 through March 31, 1961.
