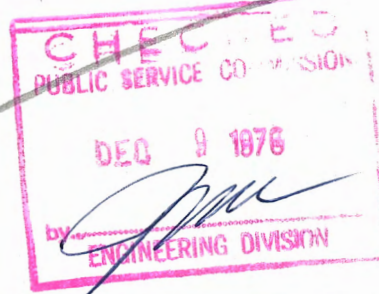

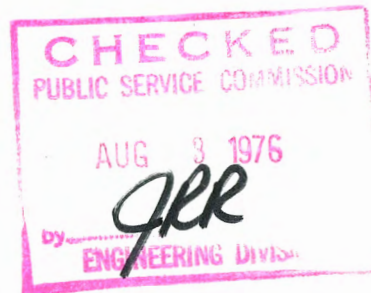

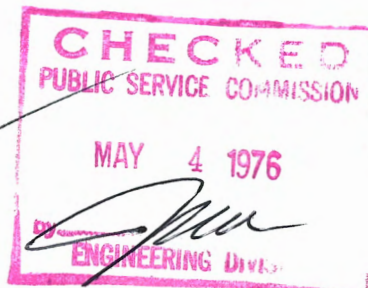

RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE SUPPLY OF GAS SERVICE

Curtailment Rules

1. Gas Rates G-2, G-6 and G-8 contain provisions relating to interruptibility. During the periods of interruption as referred to in these rate schedules or during any period when interruption or curtailment is deemed necessary to enable Company to meet its residential and other human health and safety requirements, the order of such interruption and curtailment, insofar as practicable, shall be as follows:

Step 1. Deliveries under Rate G-6

Step 2. Deliveries under Rate G-8

Step 3. Deliveries under Rate G-2

2. If, after reasonable notice from Company, any customer served under any of the above-named rate schedules fails to limit his use of gas as directed by Company, then Company shall have the right, at its option, to discontinue its entire supply of gas to such customer and to withhold such supply until assurance, satisfactory to Company, is given by the customer that any and all subsequent requests for limitation of his gas usage will be fully complied with.

3. If interruption or curtailment of service under the above-named rate schedules fails to relieve an emergency shortage of gas, the Company shall have the right to direct industrial customers under Rates G-1 and G-1A to limit their use of gas to the amount necessary to prevent damage to their equipment.

Curtailment Rules (Continued)

Company will assign Monthly Base Period Volumes to each customer in the above classes. Not less than two weeks prior to the beginning of any monthly billing period (Summer Season monthly billing periods in the case of Rate G-6), Company will notify in writing each customer in the classes named above of the percentage curtailment from such customer's Monthly Base Period Volume to be in effect in said monthly billing period, stating the volume of gas such customer is authorized to take during said monthly billing period. Provided, however, in the case of Large Industrial Customers served under Rate G-2, G-1A, or G-1, such authorized monthly volumes shall be established so as to aggregate not less than 10,000 Mcf for a twelve-month period; otherwise, the percentage of curtailment shall be uniform for all classes to which it applies.

5. Deferral of Curtailment - 1976 Summer Season. For the Summer Season beginning April 1, 1976, and ending October 31, 1976, any customer subject to pro rata curtailment who, by reason of unavoidable delay in providing alternate fuel capability, would benefit by a deferral of all or part of his curtailment until the latter months of such Summer Season may make application to Company for adjustment of his Monthly Base Period Volumes to effectuate such deferral. To the extent it can do so without detriment to other customers or to the operation of its gas system, Company will undertake, upon satisfactory showings by the applicant, to make such adjustments; but in no event will the aggregate of such Monthly Base Period Volumes for the seven summer months be increased.

6. Combination of Authorized Volumes. Subject to a written application by a customer and acceptance thereof by Company, the Company will permit any customer served through more than one point of delivery at any location, (or any person, corporation or entity served with gas at more than one location) to take gas through the points or at the locations of its choosing, provided that the gas so taken will not exceed the combined monthly authorized volumes applicable to such points of delivery, and provided that only volumes purchased under rate schedules subject to pro-rata curtailment may be so combined. In no case will the gas actually taken through any individual point of delivery exceed the Monthly Base Period Volume applicable to such point of delivery. Gas taken through each individual point of delivery will be billed at the rate applicable to such point of delivery.

If the Application referred to in the above paragraph is denied by the Company, then the Applicant may apply to the Public Service Commission for a review of the Company's decision.

The right to effect combinations of authorized volumes as here described is limited to individual customers or individual persons, corporations or entities and such right will not extend to similar combinations between or among unrelated customers.
