

In accordance with provisions of the Commission's Order of April 29, in Case No. 3286, we file herewith the following Substituted Interim Gas Rate Sheets designed to produce increased gas revenues of \$1,200,000 per year based on volume of gas sales for the 12-month period ended January 31, 1957:

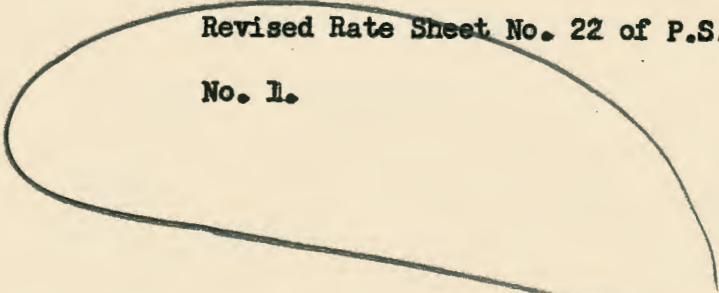
