Dear Mr. Turner:

On November 25, 2020, Louisville Gas and Electric Company (“LG&E”) filed an application with the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) for approval of adjustments to its gas and electric rates, terms, and conditions including the rates contained in the special contract under which LG&E and Kentucky Utilities Company (“KU”), on behalf of their Electric Generation Business, receive natural gas sales and transportation service under a special contract for the Mill Creek facilities.

On April 19, 2021, LG&E filed a Stipulation and Recommendation with the Commission proposing rates lower than those originally proposed in the Application dated November 25, 2020. On June 30, 2021, after evidentiary hearings, the Commission issued an Order approving the Stipulation with modifications.

The revisions applicable to gas service under the special contract with service rendered on and after July 1, 2021, are set forth below:

A portion of the special contract for service to the Mill Creek facility incorporates by reference sales service provided under Louisville Gas and Electric Company Firm Industrial Gas Rate IGS. The Sales Customer Charge for the Firm Industrial Gas Rate IGS will remain at \$24.64 per day. However, the special contract for service to the Mill Creek facility will remain at a Monthly Sales Customer
