Discontinuance of Service: (continued)

a dangerous condition is found to exist on the customer's or applicant's premises, when a customer or applicant refuses or neglects to provide reasonable access to the premises, for fraudulent or illegal use of service, or for nonpayment of bills. If discontinuance is for non payment of bills, the customer shall be given at least ten (10) days written notice, separate from the original bill, and cut-off shall be effective not less than twenty-seven (27) days after mailing of the original bill unless, prior to discontinuance, a residential customer presents to the utility a written certificate, signed by a physician, registered nurse, or public health officer, that such discontinuance will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity on the affected premises, in which case discontinuance may be effected not less than thirty (30) days from the date the utility notifies the customer, in writing, of state and federal programs which may be available to aid in payment of bills and the office to contact for such possible assistance.

Customer Billing Provisions:

Each customer or applicant will receive a bill for service each month on or near the first day of the month. Each bill rendered will show all the necessary billing information as required by the Commission. Payment will be due on or before ten (10) days. If payment is not received by the Company within the ten day period, the gross amount as shown on the bill would then be due.

Continuous and Uniform Pressure:

The Company shall supply gas continuously and without interruption and adopts and shall maintain, subject to the Commissions regulations, a standard pressure of seven (7) inches w. c. as measured at the outlet side of the customers meters. However, the Company shall assume no liability for any damage or loss resulting from inadequate or interrupted supply or from any pressure variations when such conditions are not due to willful fault or neglect on its part.
