I. RESTORATION AND TRANSFER OF GAS SERVICE

During the existence of the gas supply emergency and until further notice, restoration of gas service and transfer of gas service shall be subject to the following guidelines:

A. RE-ESTABLISHMENT OF SERVICE

Residential:

Service will not be restored at any location which has not been a customer for 24 months.

Industrial and Commercial:

Service will not be restored at any location which has not been a customer for 12 months.

B. INVOLUNTARY RELOCATION (e.g. urban renewal, highway construction, etc.)

Residential, Commercial and Industrial:

1. Service must be restored within 24 months for a residential customer since gas service has been turned off, and 12 months for a commercial or industrial customer since gas service has been turned off.
2. Volumes and load profiles must be approximately the same.
3. Existing structures must be demolished.
4. The property owners' right to the heating gas are superior to those of a tenant or tenant structure owner; but the tenant customers' right to processing gas is superior to those of the land owner.

C. TRANSFER OF GAS VOLUMES

Except for internal transfer within an industry, there will be no transfer of commercial or industrial volumes.
