6. BILLING AND PAYMENT (Continued)

6.2 Payment. Buyer shall pay Seller at its general office, 99 North Front Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215, or at such other address as Seller shall designate on or before the twentieth (20th) day following the date of the final monthly meter reading for the gas delivered hereunder during the preceding billing month.

If presentation of a bill by Seller is delayed after the tenth (10th) day following the date of final monthly meter reading, then the time of payment shall be extended accordingly unless Buyer is responsible for such delay.

Should Buyer fail to pay all of the amount of any bill as herein provided when such amount is due, interest on the unpaid portion of the bill shall accrue from the due date until the date of payment at the maximum lawful rate of interest provided by statute. If such failure to pay continues for thirty (30) days after payment is due, Seller, in addition to any other remedy it may have hereunder, may, after application to and authorization by the governmental authority having jurisdiction, suspend further delivery of gas until such amount is paid; provided, however, that if Buyer in good faith shall dispute the amount of any such bill or part thereof and shall
