 - (b) There exists sufficient identity of ownership or control of the premise or premises from which the transfer is made and the premise or premises to which the transfer is to be made, has the same classification of use that the applicant can demonstrate and guarantee to the Company's satisfaction that the gas entitlement will terminate at the old location and that the transfer will result in no net increase in connected load or gas usage.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

GAS MAIN EXTENSION AND LINE DEPOSIT REFUND PLAN

These rules are established pursuant to Orders of the Public Service Commission of Kentucky dated March 17, 1975 and March 20, 1975 in Case Nos. 6168 and 6191 (hereinafter referred to as the "Order"). These rules shall remain in effect until revised or modified by further Commission order or by a lawfully effective filing by the Company.

1. Except for extensions to connect applicants which the Company has an obligation or commitment to serve under the provisions of the Order, the Company will make no extensions to or enlargement of its existing gas mains for the purpose of connecting new customers or serving increased requirements of existing customers.
2. For any customer which the Company is obligated to serve under the provisions of the Order, the Company will extend its gas mains for a distance of up to 100 feet for a permanent type residence at its own expense and will extend its mains for a distance of up to 50 feet for a mobile home at its own expense. The Company will extend its mains in excess of the above specified footage provided the applicant makes a non-refundable contribution in an amount equal to the estimated cost of such excess portion of the extension. Extension allowances of more than 100 feet may be made for commercial or industrial customers which the Company is obligated to serve under the terms of the Order.
3. With respect to refunds of amounts advanced by applicants under previously effective gas distribution mains extension and deposit agreements, the Company will make refunds as follows:
 - (a) If all or part of a gas main was constructed prior to April 01, 1975, the Company will make refunds for any permanent type residences or mobile homes which are adjacent to an existing main or within the above specified footage in the amount specified in the gas distribution mains extension and deposit agreement regardless of the type of energy used by a permanent type residence or mobile home. Said refunds shall be made once each year during the month of December. Refunds will be made over a period of ten (10) years from the date of execution of the gas distribution

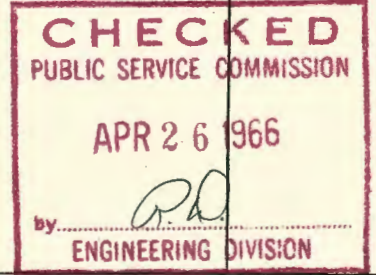



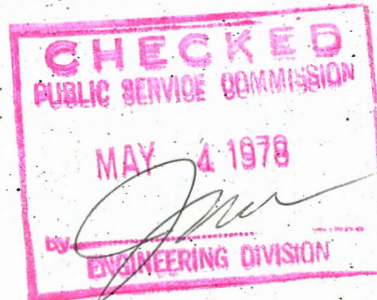
