a dangerous condition is found to exist on the customer's or applicant's premises, when a customer or applicant refuses or neglects to provide reasonable access to the premises, for fraudulent or illegal use of service, or for nonpayment of bills. If discontinuance is for non payment of bills, the customer shall be given at least ten (10) days written notice, separate from the original bill, and cut-off shall be effective not less than twenty-seven (27) days after mailing date of the original bill unless, prior to discontinuance, a residential customer presents to the utility a written certificate, signed by a physician, registered nurse, or public health officer, that such discontinuance will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity on the affected premises, in which case discontinuance may be effected not less than thirty (30) days from the date the utility notifies the customer, in writing, of state and federal programs which may be available to aid in payment of bills and the office to contact for such possible assistance.

Customer Billing Provisions:

Each customer or applicant will receive a bill for service each month. Each bill rendered to the customer will show the following information: Customer Account Number, Service from and to Dates, Meter Reading (Previous and Present), Usage, Amount, School Tax, Sales Tax, Gross Amount, Net Amount, Due Date, and any other necessary billing information that might be required by the Commission. Each customer or applicant will receive a bill for service on the first day of each month, or as near to the first as possible, Payment of the bill will be due in full on or before ten (10) days. If payment is not received in the office of the Company within the ten days, the gross amount will then be due from the customer or applicant. If remittance is mailed, the postmark must be within the ten day payment period. If such payment is not received, the gross amount of the bill would then become due. The gross amount would be the amount due for service plus ten percent (10%) plus any other charges due.
