RULES AND REGULATIONS

These Rules and Regulations govern the furnishing of sewage service by Delaplain Disposal Company. No employee or individual director of Delaplain Disposal Company is permitted to make an exception to Rates, Rules or Regulations. These Rules and Regulations are to be in effect so long as they are not in conflict with Public Service Commission Rules and Regulations.

These Rules and Regulations may be revised, amended, supplemented or changed from time to time subject to approval of the Public Service Commission, and shall have the same force as the present Rules and Regulations.

BILLING PROCEDURE

Bills are mailed no later than the third day of each month and are due and payable on or before the end of the month. There is no late payment penalty.

DEPOSIT POLICY

No cash deposit is required from customer or applicant.

DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE

Services will be discontinued for non-payment of bill after ten days after written notice is given and all reasonable efforts fail in collecting same.

NORMAL EXTENSION OF SEWER

An extension of 25 feet or less per applicant shall be made by Delaplain Disposal Company to an existing sewer line without charge to the applicant for sewage service provided that the applicant agrees to take such service for one year or more.

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Other Extensions

To accommodate one or more applicants for service from the same extension in those instances where the total length of the extension exceeds 25 feet per applicant, Delaplain may require a deposit from each applicant that will cover the cost of the extension that exceeds 25 feet per applicant. The amount of the deposit will be based on the average cost per foot of the sewer extension work, including manholes. Applicant shall agree to use the

Refunds to Customers

Each customer who has paid Delaplain for extending a sewer line more than 25 feet will be reimbursed under the following plan: At the end of each year of the 10-year period following completion of the sewer extension, Delaplain will, for each new customer connected to a sewer extension previously installed at the cost of an existing customer pursuant to the provision set forth above during that year, refund to those customers who had previously paid their part of the extension cost, an equal share of the cost of 25 feet of the original cost of the sewer extension. In no case will the accumulated refunds made by Delaplain exceed the amount deposited with Delaplain to pay for the extension. No refunds will be made after expiration of the 10-years refund period.

Extension to Serve a Proposed Real Estate Development

An applicant for sewer extensions to serve a proposed real estate development may be required to pay all of the costs of the extension.

Extensions Under Other Arrangements

Delaplain may make extensions under other arrangements that have not been defined herein provided such arrangements have been approved by the Commission.

Extensions Greater Than 25 Feet at Delaplain's Expense

Delaplain may in some instances make, at its own expense, an extension greater than 25 feet provided such extension is not discriminatory to its other customers or applicants for service.

Any and all rules that have not been defined herein apply as provided they have been approved by the commission.

Monitoring of Customer Usage

The company will monitor the demand for treatment of wastewater. Should the demand for treatment increase substantially, we will investigate the increase and make adjustments accordingly.
