SERVICE CONNECTION CHARGES

A. GENERAL

- 1. The term "Service Connection Charges" is used to define the nonrefundable charge made for the establishment of a class of telephone service or subsequent additions to that service.
- 2. No distinction is made between a "New Installation" and an "Outside Move." All changes of subscribers' equipment or service from one premises to another are treated as new service connections with Service Connection Charges applying. (For definition of "Premises" see "Definitions" under General Rules and Regulations, Part I.)
- 3. Service Connection Charges are in addition to any other schedules rates and charges normally applying under the tariffs. They apply in addition to and not in lieu of Mileage Charges, Installation Charges, or Construction Charges made because of unusual costs in establishing service.
- 4. Service Connection Charges may be payable at the time application is made for the particular service or facility, and prior to the establishment of service, or upon presentation of a bill. Service may be established in advance of payment in the case of Service Connection Charges for additions to the service of existing subscribers and in the case of any service for Departments, Administrations, and Agencies of the Federal, State, County, Township or Municipal Governments.

 - 1. The NETWORK INTERFACE is the point of interconnection between the C1 1997 (N) telephone company facilities (regulated) and the subscriber OFANY TO BOT KARENIL, customer's wiring (unregulated). The NETWORK INTERFACE and SECTION 9(1) DEMARCATION POINT have same meaning. BY: 9. Leogregen
 - 2. In the absence of a distinct or definable network interface or demarcation point the station protector shall be defined as the network interface/demarcation point.
 - 3. All Network interfaces installed after 1-1-87 will be installed in such a way as to allow easy access for customer performed trouble isolation. Normally this will be a RJ11 jack but could be any F.C.C. approved jack, this will be the telephone company's option as to type jack used.
 - 4. Customers who report trouble with their service and a company employee isolates the trouble to the customer's side of the network interface, that customer will be billed the maintenance service call as shown in PART II sheet 9A of this tariff. When the company incorrectly identifies a service problem as being the customer's responsibility, then the company will reimburse the customer for any reasonable expenses incurred. The amount reimbursed will not exceed the amount of the maintenance of service call as shown in PART II 9A in this tariff. All claims must be in writing and accompanied by a copy of the bill provided by a company that is in the business of offering maintenance of inside wire service to the public.
 - 5. The company will provide facilities to the first point (demarcation/ network interface in or next to station protector) on the customer's premises which, in the judgment of the company, is suitable for the location of a network interface. The most economical route from existing network distribution facilities will generally determine the approach used in establishing the point-of-demarcation. The customer may designate an alternate approach route for the entrance facilities at additional charges on a per cost basis. Route selection and location of point-ofdemarcation must be in compliance with the latest edition of the National Electric Code, F.C.C. Part 68 and regulations of this tariff.
 - 6. Customers who had distinct and definable network interface installed before 1-1-87 may continue to use the interface at its persent location until there is a need for the wiring to be changed or rearranged.

After the initial installation of the protector/interface, should conditions at the location of the protector/interface change, such as the protector/interface or its unshielded supply wire being enclosed in new construction, should the area become unsafe for the telephone employees to work, telephone employees are being denied access, the use of the area around the protector/interface changes and the presence of the protector/interface could be a safety hazard to the building or to it's occupants, or the protector/interface itself could become damaged. The telephone company will move the protector/interface to a "suitable" location and bill the subscriber the appropriate charges as shown elsewhere in this tariff.
 - 11. If a telephone company employee is dispatched to fill a service request or repair a trouble (and the subscriber is aware of the impending visit) and is denied access to the area where the protector/interface is located, the telephone company may bill the subscriber a premise visit charge as shown elsewhere in this tariff and no credit for interrupted service will be allowed.

- 7. Access Line Service is provided for use by the subs**CUBLIC:SERVICE.COMMISSION** be used by others when so authorized by the subscriber, performance of the provisions of this Tarried IVE
- 8. Access Line Service is not subject to concessions. MAR 27 1998
- 9. Access Line Service may not be suspended at a reduced rate. PURSUANT TO 807 KAR 5:011.
- 10. Access Line Service for PSP Public Telephones cannot be in **SEQUON** 9(1) on accounts containing other classes of service. A separate back be account is required for this offering at each location secretary OF THE COMMISSION
- 11. The operator cannot perform coin collecting functions.
- 12. The Company is not responsible for refunds of coins deposited in PSP Public Telephones.

- C. Service Options
 - 1. At the request of the subscriber, certain options may be added to the access line for Public Telephone Service and will be billed at the approved tariff rate. All options must be compatible with the hardware and software in use by the existing telephone Company switching equipment.
 - a. Coin Supervision Additive Service

The Company will provide Coin Supervision Additive Service to PSPs who order Access Line Service for the provision of Public Telephone Service and where the Public Telephone equipment connected to the Access Line Service requires central office coin supervision capability.

Coin Supervision Additive Service provides the capability of central office line equipment to pass signals and/or tones from the Access Line Service to a trunk terminating at the PSP's operator service provider. These signals enable an operator service provider to recognize coin deposits. Coin Supervision Additive Service also permits a suitable equipped operator service provider to automatically ring back the originating access line upon completion of a call.

This option requires a special central office line card which differs from the standard access line card and will be provided where facilities exist. The Company's central offices are only equipped for semi-postpay supervision.

b. Public Telephone Screening / Blocking

Screening / Blocking for Public Telephone access lines includes Company provided services necessary to coordinate with operator connections or block subscribers from making specific types of calls. #### FOREIGN EXCHANGE SERVICE

- Except in the case of tie lines and individual private branch exchange stations, the rate for foreign exchange service is the monthly rate for individual line main station service, private branch exchange trunk lines or private branch exchange system applicable within the base rate area of the designated central office of the foreign exchange area, plus charges as follows for each circuit:
  - a. \$<u>1.00</u> per month per quarter-mile of fraction thereof, for the distance, route measurement, between the central office from which the subscriber normally would be served and the central office in the foreign exchange from which the subscriber desires to be served or in the event the Telephone Company has no exchange in any foreign territory or on account of non-patronage or circumstances beyond its (I) control, an exchange is discontinued and any individual main station or private branch exchange system applicable within such foreign exchange rate of \$<u>1.00</u> per quarter-mile per month applies. In addition the subscriber is charged with any extra exchange line mileage charges which would apply for connection with the central office from which service normally would be rendered.
- 2. For tie lines connecting switchboards in different exchange area, mileage charges apply as follows for each circuit:
  - a. <u>\$1.00</u> per month per quarter-mile or fraction thereof for the dis- (I) tance, route measurement, between the switchboards.
- 3. The charge for individual private branch exchange stations connected for foreign exchange service, is the monthly rate applicable for other private branch stations connected to the same private branch exchange switchboard, plus mileage charges as follows for each circuit:

- 4. Foreign exchange service is furnished subject to the same restrictions as to the use of the service by others than the subscribers and his representatives, as apply in connection with other classes of exchange service.
- 5. Subscribers to foreign exchange service are required to contract for service in the exchange from which they would normally be served. The minimum requirement is one individual line or one trunk.
- 6. The local service area and toll rates to main stations or private branch exchange systems connected for foreign service are the same as regularly apply to stations located in the foreign exchange area. Charges, if any, for messages to foreign exchange main stations or private branch exchange systems are the established rates for messages to stations located in the foreign exchange area.
- 7. Where foreign exchange service is provided through the interexchange facilities of Another Telephone Company, the charges for this type service shall be in accordance with the contractual agreements between this Telephone Company and that Other Telephone Company, but in no event shall the charges to the subscriber for the services and facilities furnished by this Telephone Company be less than the rates for those same services and facilities as given under paragraphs 1 through 6 above.
- 8. The rates quoted herein contemplate the use of standard equipment and the installation of wiring required for standard equipment. Special equipment, facilities, and wiring are furnished, where practicable, at charges as determined by the provisions under Miscellaneous Services and Facilities or other applicable sections in this Tariff.

#### INTERCONNECTION WITH CUSTOMER-PROVIDED EQUIPMENT AND SYSTEMS

#### A. GENERAL

The Federal Communications Commission, in their Docket 19528 permits direct interconnection of customer provided equipment (CPE). These sheets of the Tariff provide for implementation of this ruling and applies to the direct connection to the network of ancillary equipment other than coin telephones used in conjunction with all primary individual telephone service.

- 1. Customer-provided equipment not permitted on party line service.
- 2. Except for Telephone Company provided ringers, all connection of equipment will be made through standard jacks provided by the Telephone Company and through standard customer provided plugs. The jack will be of modular design as prescribed by the FCC and must be wired so that there will be no interference to the rest of the service if the plug is withdrawn.
- 3. All customers who purchase their own equipment will advise the Telephone Company of its presence, registration number, its ringer equivalence number, U.S.O.C. number, and the lines to which the registered equipment will be connected.
- 4. A customer who fails to notify the Telephone Company of connection of grandfathered or registered terminal equipment or protective circuitry or is otherwise in violation of applicable laws, rules and regulations will be subject to discontinuance of service.
- 5. The use of customer provided circuitry or terminal equipment shall not require change in, or alteration of the equipment or other facilities of the Telephone Company. If any such circuitry or terminal equipment is found defective, its use shall be immediately discontinued until correction is made.
- 6. Telephone Company repair persons are not permitted to cerair D customer owned equipment. Repair of customer public der an authorized service agent.

- 7. A charge applying when the subscriber requests a service call for repairs (when the subscriber owns all or part of the terminal equipment) and the Telephone Company's facilities are found not to be causing the trouble. That charge appears in Part II, Sheet 9A of this Tariff.
- 8. In the event the subscriber should elect to provide the station wire. Registered Protective Circuitry must be provided by the subscriber or by the Telephone Company at a reasonable charge. Registered Protective Circuitry: Meaning separate, identifiable and discrete electrical circuitry designed to protect the telephone network from harm, which is registered in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Federal Communications Commission (F.C.C.).
- 9. Station wiring provided by the subscriber without Registered Protective Circuitry must be of the same quality and meet the same specifications as those used by the Telephone Company. To insure these standards, the Telephone Company must inspect subscriber provided wiring. That charge being a service order charge and a premise visit charge, as shown elsewhere in these Tariffs, per inspection.

## A. GENERAL

      - (c) Customers who have been certified by a physician or appropriate agency as unable to use telephone directory because of a visual or physical handicap.
    - 2. Chargeable Calls

For charging purposes a call to Local Directory Assistance is defined as a call:

- (a) Resulting in obtaining a maximum of two telephone numbers; or
- (b) Resulting in obtaining no telephone number because there was no such listing or there was a private listing.

- a. Verification service provides operator assistance in determining if a called (N) line is in use. #### SHARED TENANT SERVICE

## A. GENERAL

- 1. In general, basic local exchange service is furnished for the exclusive use of the subscriber, and the subscriber's family, guests, employees, agents, or representatives. Resale of basic local exchange service is permitted only under the specific conditions described in this tariff.
- 2. The customer must apply in writing to resell exchange services provided by the Company. When in judgment of the Company it is deemed necessary, the reseller may be required to submit layout maps defining the intended geographic resale area and anticipated development plan in terms of new or existing buildings.
- 3. All rates and charges in connection with the resale operation and all repairs and rearrangements behind and including the reseller's communication system will be the responsibility of the reseller. The reseller will be the single point of contact for all shared tenant services provided in the resale service area. Tenants who choose to obtain service directly from the Company may subscribe to any local exchange service available.
- 4. Nothing in this tariff section impairs the Company's franchise or ability to operate in the state. This tariff is not intended, nor does it, enfranchise or certify the recepients of this service as a tele-communications company.
- 5. Shared Tenant Service should be permitted where facilities are available within continuous property areas under single ownership or within common developments with a single name identity, such as multi-tenant office buildings, apartment and condominium complexes, commercial malls, campus complexes, offices and industrial parks. "Single ownership" should be interpreted so as to mean not only an individual owner, but also ownership in the form of a corporation, jointventure, or partnership with a single name identity. "Continuous property" should be construed to mean property that is not intersected by property owned by other entities. Furthermore, continuous property can be intersected by public thoroughfares, railroads, and other public and private rights of way, provided that the property would be continuous in the absence of such intersections. Continuous property may straddle exchange boundaries. In such cases, the most economic exchange will be selected.

  - 4. The minimum period of service is 36 months with a service cancellation (N) charge applicable at the date of termination based on the exchange rates in effect. The service cancellation charge is reduced 1/36 per month and will be an amount equal to the exchange rates for the maximum number of lines subscribed to during the service period. A nine month notice is required prior to termination of service by the reseller.
  - 5. When a tenant located within the designated resale service area wishes to be directly served by the Telephone Company on a non-resale basis, or when Brandenburg Telephone Company or customer provided coin telephone service is to be provided in the resale service area, the reseller will bear the responsibility for and cost of providing premises access for such services. The customer may designate an alternate approach route for entrance facilities at additional charges on a per cost basis. Route selection and location of point-of-demarcation must be in compliance with the latest edition of the National Electric Code, regulations of this tariff and F.C.C. Part 68.
  - 7. Upon ordering this service, the customer/reseller will be required to fill out a shared tenant service application. This will consist of the name of a point of contact, address and phone number along with a brief description of the shared tenant service area including layout maps. Information should be given at this time to establish credit and the amount of deposit. (N)

#### TELECOMMUNICATIONS RELAY SERVICE (For Hearing-Impaired or Speech-Impaired Persons in Kentucky)

#### Α. Regulations

- On April 15, 1991, The Kentucky Public Service Commission approved 1. a program for Kentucky Telecommunications Relay Service (KTRS) pursuant to KRS 278.548. This Service provides telephone communications between deaf and hearing / speech impaired customers who use Telecommunications Devices for The Deaf ("TDD") and all customers who use standard voice telephones. The service began operation on October 1, 1991.
- The Kentucky Telecommunications Relay Service operates 24 hours a day, 2. seven days a week. Customers can access the center using toll-free numbers.
- 3. Effective on March 15, 1995 the Kentucky General Assembly established a program now called the Telecommunications Access Program (TAP) for Kentuckians who are deaf, hard of hearing, or speech impaired.
- Funding of the Relay Center and TAP distribution program is through 4. a surcharge per access line.
- в. Surcharge Rate
  - Recovery of state costs associated with the Telephone Relay Service 1. (TRS) and TAP program is based on a fixed monthly charge per access line.
  - 2. For purposes of application of the surcharge, access lines are defined as facilities that provide access to and from the telecommunications network for toll service and / or for local calling. Public Coin, WATS, Remote Call Forwarding, Radio Common Carriers, InterLATA Foreign Exchange Lines, Private Line Services, Mobile, Other Common Carriers, and Company official Accounts are excluded from this category.
  - The monthly surcharge will appear in customer invoices labeled, 3. "KY TRS/TAP Surcharge."
  - The monthly surcharge amount will coincide with the current 4. т rate prescribed by the Kentucky Public Service Commission. т
