At the conclusion of this initial investigation, the designated water system staff person(s) shall set out the findings and conclusions in a **signed, time stamped, and dated report**. If it is determined that a contamination event has occurred, or that a threat of contamination exists, the designated water system staff person(s) shall immediately proceed with those actions set out in Sections 3 and Section 4 of the Emergency Response Plan as follows.

Section Three: Notification of Emergency Responders, Regulatory Agencies, Adjacent Water Systems, Local Elected Officials (County Judge Executives and City Mayors), and Other Water System Staff

Section Five: Alternative Water Sources

If the primary water source has to be shut down due to contamination, it may be necessary to depend on a secondary or emergency water supply.
