RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Rules and Regulations of the Cannonsburg Water District are subject to change by the Water District Commission subject to approval by the Kentucky Public Service Commission.

1. Water meters shall be read monthly commencing on the 15th day of each calendar month or as soon thereafter as weather and other conditions and circumstances may reasonably permit.

If it is found that the meter of a customer is defective or non-operative, such water bill shall be computed on the basis of the average monthly water consumption of such customer shown by the three preceding monthly meter readings, provided that if no such readings are then available, the applicable water bill will be computed on the basis of an estimate of water consumption subject to adjustment to the average of the next three succeeding monthly meter readings.

2. The rates or charges for water service shall be billed monthly on or about the twentieth of the month, and all bills for such services shall be considered due and payable within twenty days. If a bill is not paid within such twenty-day period, there shall be imposed a penalty on each bill not so paid, in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the charges (other than sales tax) shown on the face amount of said bill. If a bill is not paid within said twenty-day period after said due date, the charges shown on such bill shall be deemed delinquent, and the Superintendent of the waterworks system, after furnishing 48 hours written notice to the delinquent water user, shall thereupon, turn off the water of such user.

3. If such water service is cut off by the District, reconnection of such service shall be made when the customer pays all charges and penalties owed plus the amount of Eight dollars (\$8.00) as a reconnection charge.

4. There are five facilities for the payment of water bills: (1) The bank of Ashland - (Cannonsburg Branch), (2) The Cannonsburg Water District Office, located at Rt. #180 in Cannonsburg, (3) The Kentucky Farmers Bank - (Summit Branch), (4) The Third National Bank - (Summit Branch), and (5) The Frist Bank and Trust Co. (Formerly Second National Bank) - (Meade Station Branch). The office hours are from 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m., Monday thru Friday, excepts Holidays.

5. The cost for connection to our water lines shall be Two Hundred and Twenty-five Dollars (\$225.00), per connection for 5/8" x 3/4" meter service.
