The Green River Valley Water District may require a minimum cash deposit or other guaranty to secure payment of bills except for customers qualifying for service reconnection pursuant to 807 KAR 5:006, Section 15, Winter Hardship Reconnection. Service may be refused or discontinued for failure to pay the requested deposit. Interest, as prescribed by KRS 74.050 will be paid annually either by refund or credit to the customer's bill, except that no refund or credit will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent on the anniversary date of the deposit.

The deposit may be waived upon a customer's showing of satisfactory credit or payment history, and required deposits will be returned after one (1) year if the customer has established a satisfactory payment record for that period. If a deposit has been waived or returned and the customer fails to maintain a satisfactory payment record, a deposit may then be required. The Green River Valley Water District may require a deposit in addition to the initial deposition if the customer's classification of service changes or if there is a substantial change in usage. In determining whether a deposit will be required or waived, the following criteria will be considered:

- 1. Previous payment history with the Green River Valley Water District. If the customer has no previous history with the Green River Valley Water District, statements from other utilities, banks, etc. may be presented by the customer as evidence of good credit.
- 2. Whether the customer has an established income or line of credit.

4. Whether the customer owns property in the area.

The District may require any customer or applicant for service to make a cash deposit or other guaranty to secure payment of bills in an amount not to exceed 2/12ths of the estimated annual bill of such customer or applicant. A fifteen dollar (\$15) service charge shall be required of all residential users to cover the cost of turning on the water for that customer if the service is turned on during regular working hours. If it is after regular working hours, then a thirty dollar (\$30) charge shall be required of that customer.
- 1. A tap fee in the amount of \$490.30 shall be charged all users who have a 5/8" x 3/4" meter.
- 2. A tap fee in the amount of \$597.60 shall be charged all users who have a 1" meter.
- 3. A tap fee in the amount of \$1,463.87 shall be charged all users who have a 2" meter.
- 4. A tap fee in the amount of \$3,095.95 shall be charged all users who have a 3" meter.
- 7. All bills are due and payable by no later than the 10th day of each month. All customers who have not paid their bills by twenty days after the date of billing shall have their water service disconnected until such time as their delinquent bill has been paid in full and a fifteen dollar (\$15) service charge for reconnecting that customer has been paid. If the water service is reconnected after regular working hours, then the customer shall pay thirty dollars (\$30). No customer's service will be discontinued, however, until the District has made a reasonable effort to induce the customer to pay the bill and the customer has been give at least 48 hours written notice. In no event, however, shall the cut-off occur before twenty days after the mailing date of the original bill. The termination notice will be exclusive of and separate from the original bill.
- 8. The District has the right to disconnect service immediately, Buthout Chottle, Storn fraudulent or illegal use of service as permitted by the Kentucky Revised Statutes N and the Rules and Regulations of the Public Service Commission of Kentucky.

- 9. Extension of Service: The District shall make an extension of 50 feet or less to its existing distribution main without charge for a prospective customer who shall apply for and contract to use service for one year or more and provides a guaranty for such service. The District will make other extensions of its main distribution lines to serve an applicant or group of applicants where the extension amounts to more than 50 feet per applicant, if the applicant or group of applicants agree to pay the costs in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Public Service Commission of Kentucky.
- 10. Adjustments on Bills: Whenever a meter in service is found upon periodic request or complaint to test more than two percent (2%) fast, additional tests shall be made at once to determine the average error of the meter. Said tests shall be made in accordance with the Public Service Commission's Regulations applicable to the type of meter involved. Adjustments on the customer's bill will then be made in accordance with the applicable Rules and Regulations of the Public Service Commission of Kentucky.

Any private party or entity within the District which desires N to provide themselves with water of the District at their expense shall be required to enter into a written agreement with the District and any other person on the proposed water line which sets forth the agreed terms for the installation of a private water line. The agreement shall provide that the parties shall agree upon the costs of the construction and installation and shall agree to execute a written deed of easement to the District and in the event another private party or entity requests to connect to the existing private water line, the District shall collect the agreed tap fee and the new party or entity shall pay a pro-rata fee of the original cost of the construction to the other parties. The District shall have the right to extend the private water line at any time at the cost of the District without having to pay a fee to any party to the agreement.

The District would only install fire hydrants on six inch (6") lines or larger lines. Water hydrants installed on four inch (4") lines or smaller lines will be for flushing purposes only and shall not be used as a fire hydrant. The District is not in the fire protection business.
