The furchaser agrees to give the Seiler at reast a one (1, year 3 morres the Seller commences furnishing water to a new industry, an industry that expands its present facilities, newly annexed areas, or makesmajor extension of its present water lines to serve additional customers if that new industry, expanded industry, etc. will use over 200,000 gallons of water per month.

It is further mutually agreed between the Seller and the Purchaser as follows:

- 1. (Term of Contract) That this contract shall extend for a term of <u>forty (40)</u> years from the date of the initial flivery of any water as shown by the first pill-submitted by the Seller to the Purchaser and, thereafter may be renewed or extended for such term, or terms, as may be agreed upon by the Seller and Purchaser.
- 2. (Delivery of Water) That ninety (90) days prior to the estimated date of completion of construction of the Purchaser's water supply distribution system, the Purchaser will notify the Seller in writing the date for the initial delivery of water.
- 3. (Water for Testing) When requested by the Purchaser the Seller will make available to the contractor at the point of delivery, or other point reasonably close thereto, water sufficient for testing, flushing, and trench filling the system of the Purchaser during construction, irrespective of whether the metering equipment has been installed at that time, at a

But charge of \$ 200.00 which will be paid by the contractor or, on his failure to pay, by the Purchaser.

- 4. (Faiture to Deliver) That the Seller will, at all times, operate and maintain its system in an efficient manner and will take such action as may be necessary to furnish the Purchaser with quantities of water required by the Purchaser. Temporary or partial failures to deliver water shall be remedied with all possible dispatch. In the event of an extended chartage of water, or the supply of water available to the Seller is otherwise diminished over an extended period of time, the supply of water to Purchaser's consumers shall be reduced or diminished in the same ratio or proportion as the supply to belier's consumers is reduced or diminished.
 - 5. (Modification of Contract) That the provisions of this contract pertaining to the schedule of rates to be paid by
- Purchaser for water delivered are subject to modification at the end of every <u>One (1)</u> year period. Any increase or some in rates shall be based on a demonstrable increase or decrease in the costs of performance hereunder, but such easts shall not include increased capitalization of the Seller's system. Other provisions of this contract may be modified or directed by mutual agreement.
- 6. (Regulatory Agencies) That this contract is subject to such rules, regulations, or laws as may be applicable a smaller agreements in this State and the Seller and Purchaser will collaborate in obtaining such permits, certificates, or the sec, as may be required to comply therewith.
- 7. (Miscellaneous) That the construction of the water supply distribution system by the Purchaser is being financed a loan made or insured by, and/or a grant from, the United States of America, acting through the Farmers Home Administration of the United States Department of Agricu ture, and the provisions hereof pertaining to the undertakings of the Purchaser the conditioned upon the approval, in writing, of the State Director of the Farmers Home Administration.
 - S. (Successor to the Purchaser) That in the event of any occurence rendering the Purchaser incapable of perting under this contract, any successor of the Purchaser, whether the result of legal process, assignment, or otherwise, ill succeed to the rights of the Purchaser hereunder.
- 9. Seller agrees to code to the Purchaser so much of its present territory and 5HE in Larue County, Kentucky, that the Purchaser plans to service in the corespeable future.
 - 10. This Water Purchase Contract is hereby pledged to the tred States of America, acting through the Farmers Home Administration (HA), as a part of the security for a loan or loans by the United tos of America. This pledge shall continue in effect so long as harue County Water District No. I is indebted to the Farmers Administration.
