**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**EXPLANATION OF SPECIAL CHARGES**

A. Purpose: Pursuant to the provisions of 807 KAR 5:006, Section 8, the District has adopted the following Special Charges to cover certain costs incurred for a specific customer. The purpose of these Special Charges is to keep from increasing rates to other customers who do not receive any benefits from the service provided or the action taken.

B. Special Charges:

1. Turn-On Charge. A Turn-On Charge shall be assessed for a new service Turn-On, seasonal Turn-On or temporary service. A Turn-On Charge shall not be made for initial installation of service where a tap-fee is applicable.

2. Reconnect Charge. A Reconnect Charge shall be assessed to reconnect a service which has been terminated for non-payment of bills or violation of the District's Rules and Regulations or the Public Service Commission's Regulations.

3. Termination or Field Collection Charge. A charge shall be assessed when a District representative makes a trip to the premises of a customer for the purpose of terminating service. The charge shall be assessed if the District representative actually terminates service or if, in the course of the trip, the customer pays the delinquent bill to avoid termination. The charge shall also be made if the District representative agrees to delay termination based on the customer's agreement to pay the delinquent bill by a specific date. The District shall make a Termination or Field Collection Charge only once in any billing period.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 4. **Meter Resetting Charge.** A charge shall be assessed for resetting a meter if the meter has been removed at the customer's request.
- 5. **Meter Test Charge** This charge shall be assessed if a customer requests the meter be tested pursuant to Section 18 of 807 KAR 5:006 and the test shows the meter is not more than two percent (2%) fast. No charge shall be made if the test shows the meter is more than two percent (2%) fast.
- 6. **Return Check Charge.** A Returned Check Charge shall be assessed if a check accepted for payment of a water bill is not honored by the customer's financial institution.
- 7. **Late Payment Penalty.** A penalty shall be assessed if a customer fails to pay a bill for services by the due date shown on the customer's bill. The penalty shall be assessed only once on any bill for rendered services. Any payment received shall first be applied to the bill for service rendered. Additional penalty charges shall not be assessed on unpaid penalty charges.

C. The amount of each Special Charge shall be the amount approved by the Public Service Commission. These amounts are set forth elsewhere in this Tariff.

SECTION IV

BILLS AND NOTICES

- A. Bills and notices relating to the conduct of the business of the District will be mailed to the customer at the address listed on the users agreement unless a change of address has been filed in writing with the District; and the District shall not otherwise be responsible for delivery of any bill or notice nor will the customer be excused from the payment of any bill or any performance required in said notice.
- B. Bills for water service are due and payable at the office of the District, or to any designated agent, on the date of issue. The past due date shall be the tenth day after the date of issue. Bills will be dated and mailed on the first day of each month.
- C. All bills not paid on or before the past due date shall be deemed delinquent. The district may serve a customer a written final notice of said delinquency. If delinquent bill is not paid within ten days after date of such final notice, the water supply to the customer may be discontinued without further notice.
- D. Meters will be read montly between the 8th and 25th of each month.

SECTION V

DEPOSIT

- A. The District reserves the right to request a sum of \$ 25.00 which shall not be more than 1/6 of the customer's average annual bill to be placed on deposit with the commission prior to service.
- B. Such deposit less any unpaid charges shall be refunded to the customer within thirty days after such customer notifies the District legally to disconnect or terminate service to customer.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

The following Rules And Regulations are subject to change at anytime after approval by the Public Service Commission.

**SECTION I**

TERMINATION AND/OR RECONNECTION OF WATER SERVICE

- A. There is no charge for the water meter to be turned off.
- B. A \$7.00 fee is required when a water meter is turned on again.
- C. A \$7.00 fee or charge is required for reinstalling a water meter plus the cost of any materials if any are used. There is a requirement that any past due balance owed on the meter at the time of removal must be paid prior to reinstallation.
- D. There is no charge for the removal of a water meter.
- E. The above rules apply uniformly to all customers in the service area of the district.

**SECTION II**

TAP ON FEES-SERVICE CONNECTION CHARGES: The following are tap on fees or service connection charges which are applied uniformly to all customers in the service area of the district.

- B. 1" Meter - \$410.00
- C. 1-1/2" Meter - \$800.00
- D. 2" Meter - \$1,250.00
- E. 3" Meter - \$2,090.00
- F. 4" Meter - \$3,575.00
- G. 6" Meter - \$5,550.00
- A. 5/8" x 3/4" Meter - \$325.00

**SECTION VI**

TESTING OF METER- Upon written request of any customer, the meter serving said customer shall be tested by the District. Such test will be made without charge to the customer if the meter has not been tested within 12 months preceeding the requested test; otherwise, a charge of \$2.00 will be made and then only if the test indicates meter accuracy within the limits of 2%. If a meter is inaccurate in excess of 2%, adjustments shall be made for the ~~two~~ preceeding months prior to test according to the inaccuracy in excess of 2% as set forth in Section 9 of 807 KAR 2:010 - General Rules of The Public Service Commission of Kentucky.

**SECTION VII**

FAILURE OF METER TO REGISTER- Where a meter has ceased to register, or meter reading could not be obtained, the quantity of water consumed will be based upon an average of the prior six months consumption and the conditions of water service prevailing during the period in which the meter failed to register.

**SECTION VIII**

LOSS OF SERVICE- The District shall in no event be held responsible for any claim made against it by reason of the breaking of any mains or service pipes or by reason of any other interruption of the supply of water caused by the failure of machinery or stoppage for necessary repairs. No person shall be entitled to damages nor for any portion of a payment refunded for any interruption of service which in the opinion of the District may be deemdd necessary.

**SECTION IX**

CUSTOMERS HAVING BOILERS AND/OR PRESSURE VESSELS- Customers having Boilers and/or pressure vessels receiving a supply of water from the District must have a check valve on the water supply line and a vacuum valve on the steam line to prevent collapse in case the water supply from the District is discontinued or interrupted for any reason, with or without notice.

**SECTION X**

INSPECTION OF METERS- The premises receiving a supply of water and all service lines, meters and fixtures, including any fixtures within said premises, shall at all reasonable hours be subject to inspection by the District.

**SECTION XI**

PIPING INSTALLATION- Piping on the premises of a customer must be so installed that connections are conveniently located with respect to the District lines and mains. The customer shall provide a place for metering which is unobstructed and accessible at all times.

**SECTION XII**

SERVICE LINE INSTALLATION- The customer's service line shall be installed and maintained by the customer at his own expense in a safe and efficient manner and in accordance with the District rules and regulations and with the regulations of the Department of Health.

**SECTION XIII**

LOSS OR DAMAGE TO DISTRICT'S PROPERTY- If any loss or damage to the property of the District or any accident or injury to persons or property is caused by or results from the negligence or wrongful action of the customer, member of his household, his agent or employee, the cost of the necessary repairs or replacements shall be paid by the customer to the District and any liability otherwise resulting shall be that of the customer.

**SECTION XIV**

USE OF WATER- Water furnished by the District may be used for domestic consumption by the customer, member of his household, and employees only. The customer shall not sell or give away the water to any other person.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**SECTION XV**

RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT- All customers shall grant or convey, or shall be caused to be granted or conveyed, to the District a perpetual easement and right-of-way across any property owned or controlled by the customer wherever said easement or right-of-way is necessary for the District water facilities and lines so as to be able to furnish service to the customer.

**SECTION XVI**

PAYMENT OF BILLS- The water bills shall be paid at Elizabethtown, Kentucky.

**SECTION XVII**

SEVERABILITY- If any clause, provision, paragraph or section of these rules and regulations be ruled void or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder thereof shall be intended to be adopted and shall be in full force and effect not withstanding.

**SECTION XVIII**

These rules and regulations having been adopted on November 20, 1967 shall take effect from and after said date, and any rules and regulations in conflict herewith shall be deemed repeal.
