15. Meters

All meters shall be installed, renewed, and maintained at the expense of the District, and the District reserves the right to determine the size and type of meter used.

It shall be the policy of the District to test each water meter pursuant to Public Service Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:066. In addition, upon written request of any customer, the meter servicing such customer shall be tested by the District, pursuant to Public Service Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:006, Section 19.

16. Failure of Meter

Where a meter has ceased to register, or meter reading could not be obtained, the quantity of water consumed will be based upon an average of the prior six months consumption and the conditions of water service prevailing during the period in which the meter failed to register. Should a prior six month base evaluation period not be available then quantity shall be estimated by District's engineer.

17. Right of Access

The customer shall permit the District to lay, maintain, repair, or remove such water lines as are owned by the District and located on the customer's property, with the right of ingress and egress over customer's property. The District's duly authorized representative and/or other duly authorized employee of the State Health Department bearing proper credentials and identification shall be permitted to the commission all properties for the purpose of inspection, observation measurement, sampling and testing, in accordance with the provisions of these Rules and Regulations.

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The customer shall convey, or cause to be conversion to 807 KAR 5:011, perpetual easement and right-of-way to the District sectors (1) any property owned or controlled by the customer when the said easement or right-of-way is necessary to enable the District to furnish water service to the customer.

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
