RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. These rules and regulations are in addition to the rules and regulations of the Utility Regulatory Commission of Kentucky.
2. Any resident of Laurel County Water District #2 is eligible for water service from the district.
3. Water service will be terminated within 72 hours after receiving a written request from the customer requesting discontinuance.
4. All new applications for service shall be accompanied by a deposit of 2/12 of the average annual bill, if not a property owner, to assure payment of bill.
5. A fee of \$15.00 will be charged for re-connection of service.
6. Water connection and installation fees for each standard 5/8" to 3/4" meter will be \$250.00.
7. A charge of \$3.00 will be made for all checks returned by the bank.
8. A fee of \$10.00 will be charged for retesting of meters by customer request if the meter is tested and found to be accurate, in accordance with 807 KAR 25:020.
9. A fee of \$5.00 will be charged for all additional trips to customer's premises, such as incorrect addresses given, helping customer find water leaks on their side of meter, etc.
10. Meters will be read monthly and statements mailed before the 10th of each month, ~~in accordance with 807 KAR 25:030.~~
11. Service lines to meters and meters are property of the District. From the meter to customer outlet installation and service will be the sole responsibility of customer.
12. All meters will be located on district mains and in the absence of special permission on the property to be served. Reference is made to a more detailed explanation contained in the By-Laws.
13. The principal place of business of the District will be at the Water District Office at 118 Carter Drive, London, Kentucky and bill shall be paid at same.
14. Discontinuance of service will be in accordance with 807 KAR 25:020.
15. Extension of service will be in accordance with 807 KAR 25:050.

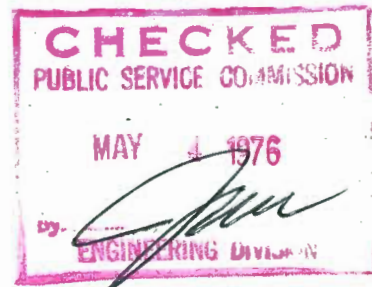

3. Water service will be terminated within 12 hours after receiving a written request from the customer requesting discontinuance.
4. All applications for service shall be accompanied by a \$20.00 deposit, if not a property owner, to assure payment of bill.
5. A fee of \$15.00 will be charged for reinstalling of services.
6. Water connection and installation fees for each standard 5/8" to 3/4" meter will be \$200.00.
7. Bills must be paid within 30 days after receipt, upon penalty of discontinuance of service.
8. Meters will be read during the last week of each month, and statements mailed before the 10th of each month.
9. Service lines to meters and meters are property of the District. From meter to customer outlet installation and service will be sole responsibility of customer.
