If the costs incurred by the district exceed the \$5,000 deposit, the customer will owe the difference to the utility. The \$5,000 deposit is for installation of service and will be in addition to the customer deposit that is collected that insures payment for water usage.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS - These Rules and Regulations are intended to supplement the Bylaws and Rate Schedules previously filed with Public Service Commission and are in addition to the Rules of the Kentucky Public Service Commission pertaining to Water Districts.
2. PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS - The principal place of business of the District will be at 4789 Main Street, Bremen, Muhlenberg County, Kentucky. Water bills will be paid at 4789 Main Street, Bremen, Kentucky.
3. BUSINESS HOURS - The office hours for the District are 8:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M., Monday through Friday. The office will be closed Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays.
4. BILLING - Meters will be read monthly between the 10th and 25th of each month. Bills will be mailed on the last working day of each month and shall be due and payable when rendered. If not paid by the 10th of the month following the date rendered, the bill shall be delinquent, and a penalty as set out in the Schedule of Special Charges shall become due and payable; provided, however, that if the 10th day shall fall upon a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, then the face amount of the bill may be paid on the next working day of the District. If the entire bill for water service, together with said penalty is not paid by the 20th of the month after the original bill is mailed, and upon at last five days written notice, then the water service connection shall be disconnected. All disconnections for non-payment shall be in accordance with 807 KAR 5:006. A copy of the billing form to be used is attached.

The District will bill the customer for one full month of minimum service if the customer has had water service for 16 days or more with a zero to 2,000 usage.

5. GENERAL - No free use of services and facilities of the District shall be granted or permitted to any user, <sup>PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION</sup> ~~except~~ <sup>SECTION 9(1)</sup> fire departments for fire protection and periodic drill purposes only.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 6. APPLICATION FOR SERVICE - Each prospective customer desiring water service is required to sign the District's Standard Contract for Water Service before service is supplied by the District. The form of this contract is filed with and made a part of these Rules and Regulations. Meters may be installed without special permission on the property to be served. A contribution in aid of construction as provided in the Schedule of Special Charges must be paid on all new connections. Applications for service connection installation will not be processed if the applicant is indebted to the District on a past due account, bad debt, or in any other fashion whatsoever. Extensions to the utility's main shall be in accordance with 807 KAR 5:066, Section 12.
- 7. POINT OF DELIVERY - The point of delivery is the point where the meter is located on the customer's premises. All water lines, plumbing and equipment beyond the meter shall be installed and maintained by the customer.
- 8. DELINQUENT HOUSEHOLD - The District may deny service to an applicant who is a member of a delinquent household where the prior customer continues to reside in the household and uses the service.
- 9. RELOCATION OF WATER FACILITIES - District may, at the request of the Customer, relocate or change existing District-owned equipment. Customer shall reimburse District for such changes at actual cost including appropriate overhead.

DEPOSITS

The District may require a minimum cash deposit or other guaranty to secure payment of bills. Service may be refused or discontinued for failure to pay the requested deposit. Interest, as prescribed by KRS.74050, will be paid annually either by refund or credit to the customer's bill, except that no refund or credit will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent on the anniversary date of the deposit.

The deposit may be waived upon a customer's showing of satisfactory credit or payment history, and required deposits will be returned after one (1) year if the customer has established a satisfactory payment record for that period. If a deposit has been waived or returned and the customer fails to maintain a satisfactory payment record, a deposit may then be required. The District may require a deposit in addition to the initial deposit if the customer's classification of service changes or if there is a substantial change in usage. Upon termination of service, the deposit, any principal amounts, and any interest earned and owing will be credited to the final bill with any remainder refunded to the customer.

In determining whether a deposit will be required or waived, the following criteria will be considered:

1. Previous payment history with the District. If the customer has no previous history with the District, statements from other utilities, banks, etc. may be presented by the customer as evidence of good credit.
2. Whether the customer has an established income or line of credit.
3. Length of time the customer has resided or been located in the area.
4. Whether the customer owns property in the area.
5. Whether the customer has filed bankruptcy proceedings within the last seven years.
6. Whether another customer with a good payment history is willing to sign as a guarantor for an amount equal to the required deposit.

If a deposit is held longer than 18 months, the deposit will be recalculated at the customer's request based on the customer's actual usage. If the deposit on account differs from the recalculated amount by more than \$10.00 for a residential customer or ten percent for a non-residential customer, the District may collect any underpayment and shall refund any overpayment by check or credit to the customer's bill. No refund will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent at the time of the recalculation.

- 10. DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE BY DISTRICT - District may refuse to connect or may discontinue service for the violation of any of its Rules and Regulations, or for violation of any of the provisions of the Schedules of Rates and Charges, or of the customer service contract. District may discontinue service to customer for the theft of water or the appearance of water theft devices on premises of customer. The District shall not be required to restore service until the customer has complied with all Rules and Regulations of the Commission and the District has been reimbursed for the estimated amount of the service rendered and for any cost incurred by reason of the fraudulent use. All discontinuance of services is subject to the Notice Requirements of 807 KAR 5:006, Section 11.
- 11. DEPOSIT - A deposit or suitable guarantee equal to approximately twice the average monthly water bill may be required of any customer before water service is supplied. The District may at its option return the deposit plus six percent annual interest to the customer after one year. Upon termination of service, deposit and interest may be applied by the District against any unpaid bills of the customer, and if any balance remains after such application is made, said balance shall be refunded to the customer. Upon demand by the customer, the District will pay or credit bill of customer with interest at the end of each year from date of deposit, providing demand is made by the customer for payment on credit. In the absence of such demand interest continues to run. District may voluntarily credit the bill with interest. C6-95
- 12. INTERRUPTION OF SERVICE - The District will use reasonable diligence in supplying water service and shall make effort to notify affected customers in the event of a service interruption and approximate time of service restoration. - 13. NOTICE OF TROUBLE - Customer shall notify the District immediately should the service be unsatisfactory for any reason, or should there be any defects, trouble or accidents affecting the supply of water. Such notices, if verbal, should be confirmed in writing. Complaints may be made to the operator of the System and may be appealed to the District's Commission within 10 days.

- 14. SERVICE AREA - The District furnishes water service to Northern Muhlenberg County, Kentucky.
- 15. WATER FAILURE - The District is responsible for water failure only when in control of the District's employees. No consumer is paid damages for equipment unless such damages are specifically found to be caused by an act of negligence on the part of the District or its employees.
- 16. PROTECTION BY CONSUMER - Consumer shall protect the equipment of the District on his premises and shall not interfere with District's property or permit interference except by duly authorized representatives of the District.
- 17. AVAILABILITY - Water service is available to any domestic, commercial or industrial consumer within the District's area.
- 18. REVISIONS - These Rules and Regulations may be revised, amended, supplemented or otherwise changed from time to time subject to approval of the Kentucky Public Service Commission, and shall have the same force as the present Rules and Regulations.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 19. **DISTRICT'S LIABILITY** - The District shall not be liable for damage of any kind whatsoever resulting from water or the use of water on the Customer's premises, unless such damage results directly from negligence on the part of the District. The District shall not be responsible for any damage done by or resulting from any defects in piping, fixtures, or appliances on the Customer's premises. The District shall not be responsible for negligence of third persons, or forces beyond the control of the District resulting in any interruption of service.
- 20. **INTERRUPTION OF SERVICE** - The District will use reasonable diligence in supplying water service, but shall not be liable for breach of contract in the event of, or for loss, injury, or damage to persons or property resulting from interruptions in service, excessive or inadequate water pressure, or otherwise unsatisfactory service, whether or not caused by negligence.
- 21. **FIRE HYDRANT AREAS** - The District's water system is primarily designed and constructed to provide only domestic water service to rural residences and businesses. The District does not generally provide fire protection to its customers or to others. Fire hydrants may, however, be installed in areas of the system which can provide adequate pressure, flow rate, and duration of flow as determined by the District.
- 22. **FIRE HYDRANTS OUTSIDE FIRE HYDRANT AREAS** - The fire hydrants installed on the distribution lines of this District outside of the fire hydrant areas referred to herein are for the sole purpose of flushing the lines, or other uses by the District necessary for proper maintenance of the lines. The District is not responsible for, nor does it guarantee, any minimum pressure or flow at these hydrants, other than the minimum required by the Public Service Commission for distribution lines. If these fire hydrants are used by fire protection units in the performance of their duty, any damage to the distribution lines, resulting from excessive pumping pressure will be the liability of that unit. New hydrants will not be installed in areas which are not capable of providing fire flows.

**SCHEDULE OF SPECIAL CHARGES**

The following charges for special services shall be made:

1. SERVICE CONNECTION CHARGE - A charge of \$15.00 shall be made for all service reconnections made.
2. METER TEST REQUEST - Upon written request and payment of \$5.00, a customer may have his meter tested provided request by the customer is not more frequent than once each twelve months. If such test shows the meter to be more than two percent fast, a refund of the \$5.00 charge shall be made and the bill adjusted accordingly. Meter test will be made in accordance with 807 KAR 5:006.
3. PENALTIES - If the water bill is not paid by the 10th of the month (or next working day for the District) following the date rendered, the bill shall be delinquent, and a penalty equal to 10% of the face amount of the bill shall become due and payable.

CONTRACT FOR WATER SERVICES

party of the FIRST PART, and MUHLENBERG COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 3, Bremen,  
Muhlenberg County, Kentucky, party of the SECOND PART.

WITNESSETH THAT for and in consideration of the efforts of the party of the SECOND PART, acting through Water District Commissioners, W. A. Stirsmen, Harry C. Wheeldon, Jr., and W. R. Dabney, the party of the FIRST PART agrees to pay a connection fee of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ at the time of signing this contract to connect to the water system and to pay at least a minimum bill monthly thereafter as soon as the meter is installed by the District and water is made available to the meter, regardless of whether the party of the FIRST PART connects to the system.

It is understood and agreed that the party of the SECOND PART reserves the right to determine the size of service connection to be used to supply water to the party of the FIRST PART. A 3/4" x 5/8" meter will be used unless the party of the FIRST PART contracts for a larger meter. All other meters will be actual cost.

A separate meter must be installed for each property owner. The party of the FIRST PART agrees not to resell water purchased hereunder.

The party of the FIRST PART agrees to permit the District to lay, maintain, repair, remove and disconnect a service line and meter, and read meters at a point on customer's property to be designated by the District for each signed connection with the right of ingress and egress on property, and to grant an easement for installation of water lines where required.

The party of the FIRST PART agrees that no other present or future source of water will be connected to any waterlines served by the District's waterlines and will disconnect from his present water supply prior to connecting to and switching to the District's system and shall eliminate their present or future cross-connections in his system.

The party of the FIRST PART shall install and maintain at his own expense a service line which shall begin at the meter and extend to the dwelling or place of use.

The party of the FIRST PART agrees to comply with and be bound by the Articles, Bylaws, Rules and Regulations of the District now in force, or as hereafter duly and legally supplemented, amended or changed. The District may terminate service to any customer for violating a District Regulation.

Deposits to insure payment of monthly water bills and penalties on delinquent water accounts shall be as the party of the SECOND PART may hereafter prescribe.

The failure of the party of the FIRST PART to pay water charges duly imposed, shall result in the automatic imposition of the following penalties:

- A. Non-payment by the 10th of the month will be subject to a penalty of ten percent of the delinquent account.
- B. Non-payment by the 20th of the month will result in the water being shut off from the party of the FIRST PART'S property.
- C. In the event it becomes necessary for the party of the SECOND PART to shut off the water, a fee of \$15.00 will be charged for reconnection of the service. The party of the FIRST PART will also be required to pay all delinquent accounts and pay the minimum water bill for the time the meter was disconnected, unless otherwise agreed to in writing.
