**AMENDMENT TO TARIFF SHEET OF  
MUHLENBERG COUNTY WATER DISTRICT**

Effective the date of approval by the Public Service Commission for the Commonwealth of Kentucky pursuant to KRS 278.170(2), the three (3) commissioners of the Muhlenberg County Water District will be authorized to receive free water for as long as they are commissioners of the Muhlenberg County Water District. The free water shall be in addition to the salary provided for by KRS 74.020(5).

The above amendment to the tariffs of the Muhlenberg County Water District was approved at a regular commission meeting on the 13 day of May, 1985.

**TARIFF FOR MOBILE HOME PARKS**

From and after the effective date hereof Mobile Home Parks situated in Muhlenberg County, Kentucky, and served by the Muhlenberg County Water District, Dean Drive, Greenville, Kentucky, shall have individual residential meters for each mobile home situated in the trailer park in compliance with all the requirements of the District.

Any existing mobile home park which is presently master metered shall on or before January 15, 2000, install residential meters for each mobile home in the trailer park which shall be installed in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Muhlenberg County Water District and at the cost per meter on the present tariff of the District. Any mobile home park failing to do so prior to January 15, 2000, may have water cut off until compliance is obtained. This action is sought because it has been determined that water has been diverted around a master meter for a mobile home park thereby allowing the mobile home park to receive water for the park that was not metered and thus not being paid for.

**CLASSIFICATION OF SERVICE**

**WATER DEPOSIT POLICY FOR WATER SERVICE APPLICANTS**

Effective with the approval of this tariff by the Public Service Commission, each applicant for water service in the territory covered by the Muhlenberg County Water District shall pay a deposit equal to twice one months average bill, which shall be paid before any water service is supplied. Said deposit shall be held until said applicant leaves the system at which time the applicant for service will be refunded their deposit plus any applicable interest which may be due, minus any portion of the deposit required to satisfy any delinquencies of bills owed to the District. The average monthly water bill shall be adjusted on an annual basis as of January 1st of each year, the first of which shall be as of the effective date of this tariff for the remaining portion of the year 2000 and thereafter on January 1st.

At the time the applicant for water service may leave the system the District shall pay to the customer interest on the deposit at the rate of interest paid to the District on the funds invested for such deposits but the rate of interest shall never exceed 6%. The interest on the deposit shall be credited to the customers account on an annual basis provided the customers account is current. If it is not current any interest shall remain with the deposit to be applied against any potential delinquency.

If the customer leaves the District and there is a deficiency owed the District after applying the applicable deposit and any accrued interest, the customer shall be liable for such amount owed as an open account. No new account shall be opened for their benefit until any arrearage is satisfied.

The procedure for monitoring of customer usage by the Muhlenberg County Water District is as follows:

- (1) The computer program of the Company prints out an edit list on all customers and compares customer usage with the 12 months immediately preceding that period. If the usage varies, a "usage varies" comment appears beside the customer's usage.
- (2) The information is studied, and if determined that the customer may have a possible problem, a letter is sent to the customer informing them of the usage variation. They are instructed of ways of determining a leak.
- (3) Where the deviation in the customer's usage is not otherwise explained, the Company will test the customer's meter to determine whether it shows an average error greater than 2 percent fast or slow.
- (4) The Company will notify the customers of the investigation, its findings, and any refunds or backbilling in accordance with 807 KAR 5:006, Section 10(4) and (5).

SUBJECT: Charges For Special Services

The following charges for Special Services shall be made:

1. Delinquent Service Charge. A reconnection charge of \$10.00 shall be made if reconnected during regular working hours.
2. Meter Reading Recheck Charge. A charge of \$5.00 shall be made for a trip to recheck a meter reading when the customer requests the meter to be rechecked for a correct reading and the meter was not misread. First trip shall be free.
3. Meter Test Request. Upon request and payment of \$10.00, a customer may have his meter tested provided request by the customer is not more frequent than one each twelve months. If such test shows the meter to be more than two percent fast or slow, a refund of the \$10.00 charge shall be made and the bill adjusted accordingly.
4. PSC Meter Test Complaint. Any customer of the District may request a meter test by written application to the Commission.
5. Service Investigation Charge. A charge of \$10.00 per trip shall be made for service investigation during regular working hours if interruption of service is not caused by failure of District's facilities. Any maintenance and repair of facilities beyond District's delivery point is the responsibility of the customer.

- 6. Billing. The above rates and charges are net. In the event that any bill is not paid within ten days from the date of bill, there shall be added to the bill an amount equal to ten percent of the net amount of the bill. Discontinuance of service for non payment of bill shall not be implemented until after twenty days from the date of the bill and consumer had been personally contacted and given a forty-eight hour notice of discontinuance of service.
- 7. Deposit. A deposit or suitable guarantee equal to approximately twice one average monthly water bill may be required of any customer before water service is supplied. Upon termination of service, deposit may be applied by the District against any unpaid bills of the customer, and if any balance remains after such application is made, said balance shall be refunded to customer, with 6% interest from date of deposit.
- 8. Point of Delivery. The point of delivery, is the point where the meter is located on the customer's premises. All water lines, plumbing, and equipment beyond the meter shall be installed and maintained by the customer.
- 9. Customer's Service Line. All service lines beyond the metering point should be installed of material consisting of copper or PVC pipe with rating of not less than 160 psi. The size of service line beyond the point of delivery should not be less than 5/8"; however, a larger size may be needed to provide adequate service. If the customer's point of use is at a higher elevation than the point of delivery, the customer should consult with a reputable engineering firm to size the service line from the point of delivery.
- 10. Right of Access. The customer must agree to permit the District to lay, maintain, repair, or remove such water lines which is the property of the District's located on the customer's property with the right of ingress and egress over the customer's property. The District's duly authorized representative and/or other duly authorized employee of the State Health Department bearing proper credentials and identification shall be permitted to enter upon all properties for the purposes of inspection, observation, measurement, sampling, and testing in accordance with the provisions of these Rules and Regulations.

- 11. Relocation of Water Facilities. District may, at the request of customer, relocate or change existing District-owned equipment. Customer shall reimburse District for charges at cost including appropriate overhead.
  - A. Residential. A contribution in aid of construction as provided in the Schedule of Rates and Charges must be paid on all new connections to the existing water line.
  - B. Commercial. Rules and Regulations for commercial service, except as noted below, are the same for residential services.
- 12. Discontinuance of Service by District. District may refuse to connect or may disconnect service for the violation of any of its Rules and Regulations, or for violation of any of the provisions of the Schedule of Rates and Changes, or of the application of a customer or contract with the customer. District may discontinue service to customer for the theft of water or the appearance of water theft devices on premises of customer. AMENDMENT TO TARIFF REGARDING DISCONNECTION POLICY

Item 34 of the tariffs of the Muhlenberg County Water District originally issued September 12, 1988, is deleted in its entirety, and in its place and stead there is asserted the current disconnection policy of the Muhlenberg County Water District which shall be effective on the date of approval by the Public Service Commission, but not earlier than July 1, 2002:

34. All customers are and shall be required to pay the amount of their respective water bills in full and without discount on or before the 15<sup>th</sup> day following the rendering of the bill for water service. If payment on the account is not received by the 16<sup>th</sup> day of the regular billing period, then the District shall issue a notice regarding the delinquent account along with a notice of intent to discontinue services nonpayment. The discontinuance of service for nonpayment of a bill shall be implemented on or after the 24<sup>th</sup> day of the billing period. POLICY OF MUHLENBERG COUNTY WATER DISTRICT  
REGARDING COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS

Upon approval of the Public Service Commission, but not earlier than July 1, 2002, the following shall be the policy of the Muhlenberg County Water District:


- (1) Any customer applying for residential or commercial water service with the Muhlenberg County Water District agrees to comply with all rules and regulations of the Muhlenberg County Water District and further agrees to notify the District of any leaks when the same are observed, insure that no one else taps into the water supply line or meter of the Muhlenberg County Water District servicing such customer or otherwise uses water which is unmetered and to otherwise comply with all rules and regulations of the District, including prompt payment of all monthly bills in accordance with the policy of the District. Any customer who does not abide by said conditions for service shall be subject to having their service terminated. Any customer who fails to pay for billed services received and whose service is subsequently discontinued for this failure shall be liable for all court costs incurred to collect the unpaid bill and for any attorneys fees awarded by a court of competent jurisdiction in any legal action to collect the unpaid bill or fees; provided, however, should the Water District turn the account over for collection by a collection agency other than an attorney and the account is collected, the District shall be entitled to receive the fee charged by the collection agency, not to exceed 35% of the amount collected, in accordance with the contract of the collection agency, a copy of which is attached hereto.

If the fire hydrant location can be certified by an engineer as meeting applicable standards for installation of a fire hydrant than the \$527.50 shall be credited against the hereinafter described expense for installation. If the engineer cannot certify the location as one acceptable for a fire hydrant then the charge of \$527.50 shall be applied toward the cost made by the engineer. If it is greater than that amount the Muhlenberg County Water District shall bear responsibility for such charge.

If a fire hydrant is certified by an engineer as being authorized for installation under applicable rules and regulations the cost for installing the fire hydrant including the \$527.50 engineering charge shall be \$2,697.14 in accordance with the attached schedule.

AMENDMENT TO WATERLINE EXTENSION POLICY

The Muhlenberg County Water District hereby deletes paragraphs 36 and 37 of the revised tariffs issued on September 12, 1988, and in their place and stead adopts the following policy to be effective on approval by the Public Service Commission of Kentucky:

1. Before any line is extended, it must be determined that the District can supply a proper volume of water at the required applicable pressure mandated by the Public Service Commission. This will be accomplished by proper testing, and an opinion of the engineer for the District shall be obtained either orally or in writing concerning whether the District can supply the water at the proper pressure. Any lines installed shall be installed under the required guidelines of the Muhlenberg County Water District, the Public Service Commission of Kentucky, and the Department of Natural Resources. No line will be installed without complying with all requirements of the District and all applicable rules and regulations of the State of Kentucky.
2. For each proposed water main extension, the District shall determine the total length of the extension. For each new customer on the line who pays the applicable charge for a new service (presently \$350.00 plus any deposit) and guarantees that they will maintain service for at least 12 months by signing a guarantee of service for 12 months at no less than the minimum rate, the District will install, at District's expense, up to 250 feet of line for each new customer who is to be located on the extension and pay said charge. Installation of the line includes providing the pipe, digging the ditch, stubbing the line for the meter, and covering the line.
3. Should the line extension exceed 250 feet, but be less than 1,000 feet, the District will additionally install the line as defined hereinabove provided the customer provides the pipe in accordance with District specifications.

4. Should the line extension exceed 1,000 feet per customer, the District will, if the customer desires, provide the pipe to the customer at cost, plus sales tax which is to be remitted to the State, and the District will install the line for the benefit of the customer for customers on the line extension at a cost of \$.65 per foot for each foot over 1,000 feet per customer for the line extension. Said rate assumes normal digging. Should blasting or other extraordinary expenses be incurred due to being outside the scope of the ability of the District to perform and outside assistance be required, then the added cost of such will be paid by the customers as part of the installation cost above the \$0.65 per foot cost and will be a refundable cost should other customers be installed within five years thereafter as provided above. A record shall be maintained on the cost of all piping installed.

5. For a period of five (5) years after the original construction of the main extension, each additional customer who shall be directly connected to the particular extension will be required to contribute to the cost of that water main extension based on a recomputation of the total cost of the original customer's contribution to that line extension. Each new customer during the succeeding five (5) years must pay a sum of money to the District, and the District then refund same to the customers on that line who contributed to the cost of the line a sum of money equal to the cost of that line extension paid by the customers recalculated so that the contribution of each customer to the line extension, including the new customer or customers, is equal. Thus all customers directly connected to each main extension for a period of five (5) years after it is placed in service are to contribute equally to the cost of the construction of that water main extension itself. The cost is that cost paid by the customers for the pipe and the cost paid by the customers for installing the line if installed by the District at the rate of \$.65 per foot for a line over 1,000 feet, and if not installed by the District by whomever it is installed, but not to exceed \$.65 per foot. Each new customer must pay the applicable "tap on fee" at the time of the

**LEAK ADJUSTMENT TARIFF FOR  
HIDDEN UNDERGROUND LEAK**

Muhlenberg County Water District hereby amends its hidden leak adjustment for all its customers, commercial and residential, effective upon the approval of same by the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky and which replaces the policy approved by the Public Service Commission of September 10, 1998.

Each customer of the District shall be entitled to a one time leak adjustment for leaks hidden in the service line between the meter and the premises. The adjustment is available to residential and commercial customers. To obtain the leak adjustment the customer must provide a plumber's statement or list of materials showing that the leak has been repaired. After verification of repairs the customer's bill will be adjusted by utilizing the customers average usage for the past twelve (12) months preceding the date of the claimed leak, omitting the usage measured during the billing period for the leak. The customer shall be charged for their average usage bill. Any usage over the average including the amount of the month of the leak shall be billed at the District's wholesale rate. If the amount of the adjusted bill shall be over one hundred dollars (\$100.00), the customer shall have ninety (90) days to pay the entire bill but if it is under one hundred dollars (\$100.00), the customer must pay same in sixty (60) days for the date of the calculation.

The Muhlenberg County Water District reserves the right to inspect all repairs and verify any information desired before making any adjustments for a claimed hidden leak.

1. Normal extension. An extension of fifty (50) feet or less shall be made by the District to its existing distribution main without charge for a prospective customer who shall apply for and contract to use service for one (1) year or more.

2. Other extensions.

(a) When a District customer desires an extension of the utility's main to serve an applicant or group of applicants and it requires more than fifty (50) feet per applicant, the District shall require the total cost of the excess footage over fifty (50) feet per customer to be deposited with the utility by the applicant or applicants, based on the average estimated cost per foot of the total extension. The total cost shall likewise include all necessary equipment, including in-line booster pumps and electricity for same, if required, in order to insure that the water provided to the applicant or applicants shall be delivered in accordance with Public Service Commission policy for pressure. The District shall be responsible for maintaining the line thereafter.

(b) Each customer who has paid for service under this extension policy shall be reimbursed as follows:

laterals therefrom, shall be required to contribute to the cost of the extension based on recomputation of both the utility's portion of the total cost and the amount contributed by the customers. The utility shall refund to those customers that have previously contributed to the cost of the extension that amount necessary to reduce their contribution to the current calculated amount for each customer connected to the extension. All customers directly connected to the extension for a five (5) year period after it is place in service shall contribute equally to the cost of construction of the extension. In addition, each customer shall pay the approved tap-on fee applicable at the time of his application for the meter connection. The tap-on fee shall not be considered part of the refundable portion of the extension and may be changed during the refund period. After the five (5) year refund period expires, any additional customer shall be connected to the extension for the amount of the approved tap-on fee only. The total amount refunded shall not exceed the amount paid the utility. No refund shall be made after the refund period ends.

3. Any applicant desiring an extension of waterline to a proposed real estate subdivision or to any other extension for any purpose shall be required to pay the entire cost of the extension, including all professional services. Any additional equipment required to be installed to insure that such extension shall properly function shall be included in the cost of such extension to be paid by the applicant. Each year, for a refund period of ten (10) years, the utility shall refund the applicant for the extension a sum equal to the cost of fifty (50) feet of the extension installed for each new customer connected during the year whose service line is directly connected to the extension installed by the developer, and not to extensions or laterals therefrom. The total amount refunded shall not exceed the amount paid to the utility. No refund shall be made after the refund period ends.
