RULES	AND REGULATIONS

Bills will be dated and mailed on the 25th. of each month. Bill will state that they are to be paid by the 10th. of the following month. If bills are not paid on or before said date, a 10% penalty shall be added to the bill. If bill and penalty is not paid on or before the 28th. day of the mailing date of the original unpaid bill service will be disconnected and the district shall apply the water deposit hereinafter provided for against the unpaid bill. Penalty charges and the balance due shall be collected by any customary and legal means available pursuant to 807 KAR 5:006 Sections 8(3) (a) and 14 (2).

The utility shall not discontinue service to any customer for nonpayment of bills (including delayed charges) without first having made a reasonable effort to induce the customer to pay. The customer shall be given at least 5 days written notice, but the cut-off date shall not be effected before 27 days after the mailing date of the original bill. Such termination notice shall be exclusive of and separate from the original bill. If prior to discontinuance of service, there is delivered to the utility office payment of the amount in arrears, then discontinuance of service shall not be made, or where a written certificate if filed signed by a physician, a registered nurse or a public health officer saying that, in the opinion of the person making the certification discontinuance of the service will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity, the affected premises, service shall not be discontinued until the affected resident can make other living arrangements or until 30 days elapse from the utility's termination date.

DEPOSITS

The Company may require a minimum cash deposit or other quaranty to secure payment of bills :

Service may be refused or discontinued for failure to pay the requested deposit. Interest, as prescribed by KRS 278.460, will be paid annually either by refund or credit to the customer's bill, except that no refund or credit will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent on the anniversary date of the deposit.

The deposit may be waived upon a customer's showing of satisfactory credit or payment history, and required deposits will be returned after one (1) year if the customer has established a satisfactory payment record for that period. If a deposit has been waived or returned and the customer fails to maintain a satisfactory payment record, a deposit may then be required. The Company may require a deposit in addition to the initial deposit if the customer's classification of service changes or if there is a substantial change in usage. Upon termination of service, the deposit, any principal amounts, and any interest earned and owing will be credited to the final bill with any remainder refunded to the customer.

In determining whether a deposit will be required or waived, the following criteria will be considered:

- 1. Previous payment history with the Company. If the customer has no previous history with the Company, statements from other utilities, banks, etc. may be presented by the customer as evidence of good credit.
 - 2. Whether the customer has an established income or line of credit.
- 3. Length of time the customer has resided or been located in the area.
 - 4. Whether the customer owns property in the area.
- 5. Whether the customer has filed bankruptcy proceedings within the last seven years.
- 6. Whether another customer with a good payment history is willing to sign as a guarantor for an amount equal to the required deposit.

If a deposit is held longer than 18 months, the deposit will be recalculated at the customer's request based on the customer's actual usage. If the deposit on account differs from the recalculated amount by more than \$10.00 for a residential customer or USI SERVICE AND STOY a non-residential customer, the Company may collect any undertakement and shall refund any overpayment by check or credit to the customer bill. No refund will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent at the time of the recalculation.

MONITORING OF CUSTOMER USAGE

At least once annually the Company will monitor the usage of each customer according to the following procedure:

- 1. The customer's annual usage for the most recent 12-month period will be compared with the annual usage for the 12 months immediately preceding that period.
- 2. If the annual usage for the two periods are substantially the same or if any difference is known to be attributed to unique circumstances, such as unusual weather conditions, common to all customers, no further review will be done.
- 3. If the annual usages differ by 1,5 percent or more and cannot be attributed to a readily identified common cause, the Company will compare the customer's monthly usage records for the 12-month period with the monthly usage for the same months of the preceding year.
- 4. If the cause for the usage deviation cannot be determined from analysis of the customer's meter reading and billing records, the Company will contact the customer by telephone or in writing to determine whether there have been changes such as different number of household members or work staff, additional or different appliances, changes in business volume, or known leaks in the customer's service line.
- 5. Where the deviation is not otherwise explained, the Company will test the customer's meter to determine whether it shows an average error greater than 2 percent fast or slow.
- 6. The Company will notify the customers of the investigation, its findings, and any refunds or backbilling in accordance with 807 KAR 5:006, Section 10(4) and (5).

In addition to the annual monitoring, the Company will immediately investigate usage deviations brought to its attention as a result of its on-going meter reading or billing processes or company inquiry.

SECTION 10.

HIDDEN LEAK ADJUSTMENT RATE.

APPLICABLE. Applicable to all customers of the Ohio County Water District, and contiguous territory thereto.

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE. Available for Residential and Commercial customers.

RATES. A charge of twenty-five (25) percent of the applicable tariff will be applied to all water usage determined to be the result of a hidden underground leak.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS. A hidden underground leak is defined as a leak in the customer service line between the meter and the premises. Hidden underground leak adjustments will be granted to residential and commercial customers. The customer must provide a plumber's statement or list of materials showing that the leak has been repaired. After verification of repairs by the water company, the bill will be adjusted by comparing the usage during the leak billing period to the average usage for the past six billing periods. A reasonable estimate will be used in cases when six prior periods of information do not exist. The excess usage will be billed at the rate specified above. Each adjustment may cover a maximum of two billing periods. Only one adjustment per calendar year is allowed. Plastic pipe for repair of underground water service lines must be certified to withstand a working pressure of 200 lbs. per square inch or greater.


