II. RULES AND REGULATIONS

- a. The leak must be verified by visual inspection by a Water District representative and a leak adjustment request form submitted.
- b. To qualify for an adjustment, the gallons billed must have increased 75 percent above the past three month's average.
- c. The adjusted bill will be based on the customer's past three months average water consumption, plus the cost of 50 percent of the gallons originally billed above his three month's average usage. This 50 percent adjustment shall only be applied to a leak of up to 700,000 gallons. Any leakage above 700,000 gallons shall be billed at 100 percent.
- d. The customer shall acknowledge in writing that he has received information from the Water District about the adjustment and has taken the necessary steps to correct the deficiency in his service line. No more than one adjustment will be made within a 12 month period.
- e. The customer shall acknowledge in writing that he has been advised to replace his service line in accordance with the Plumbing Code with pipe that has a pressure rating of not less than 160 psi. No further Customer Service Line Leak Adjustments will be made until these recommendations are followed.
- f. All adjustments must be approved by the General Manager and reported to the Board of Commissioners.
