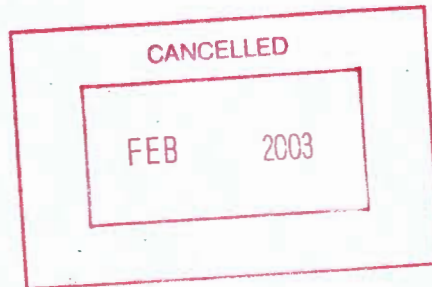

RULES AND REGULATIONS

This schedule of Rules and Regulations governs the furnishing of water service by Webster County Water District hereinafter referred to as the Utility and applies to all service received from the Utility. No employee or individual director of the Utility is permitted to make an exception to Rates, Rules or Regulations. All Rules and Regulations are to be in effect so long as they are not in conflict with Public Service Commission Rules and Regulations. The Utility is further subject to all Rules and Regulations of the Commission even though not contained herein.

REVISIONS

These Rules and Regulations may be revised, amended, supplemented or otherwise changed from time to time subject to approval of the Public Service Commission; and shall have the same force as the present Rules and Regulations.

SERVICE AREA

The Utility furnishes water service to the Community of Onton, the Towns of Slaughters, Dixon, Clay, and Wheatcroft, in Webster County, Kentucky. The community of Poole is a part of the Henderson County Water District, and the Community of Diamond is served by the City of Providence. With the exception of the Breaton area as between Onton and Slaughters, there are very few service lines in the District at this time, and the primary service line follows the main line as outlined above, from Onton to Wheatcroft. Therefore, a major portion of the county is not as yet serviced by the District.

AVAILABILITY

Water service is available to any domestic, commercial, or industrial consumer within the Utility's area.

WATER FAILURE

~~The Utility is responsible for water failure only when in control of the Utility's employees. No consumer is paid damages for equipment unless such damages are specifically found to be caused by an act of negligence on the part of the Utility or its employees.~~

PROTECTION BY CONSUMER

Consumer shall protect the equipment of the Utility on his premises and shall not interfere with Utility's property or permit interference except by duly authorized representatives of the Utility.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

NOTICE OF TROUBLE

Consumer shall give immediate notice to the Utility of any irregularities or unsatisfactory service and of any defects known to consumer.

MAINTENANCE

The Utility may at any time deemed necessary, suspend water service to any consumer or consumers for the purposes of making repairs, changes or improvements upon any part of its system. The Utility shall give reasonable notice of such suspension of service to the customer.

The Utility shall be responsible for the maintenance of that portion of the service line installed by the Utility and the consumer shall be responsible for the maintenance of that portion thereof installed by the consumer.

EXTENSION OF SERVICE.

Extension of service shall be in accordance with 807 KAR 5:066E, Section 12.

LINE RELOCATIONS

When necessary to move or relocate facilities, the cost will be paid by party or parties requesting such relocation.

BILLING, COLLECTION, PENALTIES

Bills for water service furnished by the water system will be mailed no later than the 3d day of each month and will be due and payable within ten days. A \$0.50 late payment penalty will be applicable after the due date of any account.

DEPOSITS

A deposit will be required for each new customer now that the line has been established, not to exceed 2/12 of the individual customer's estimated annual bill.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE BY UTILITY

The Utility may refuse or discontinue service to an applicant or customer after proper notice, for failure to comply with its rules and regulations or state and municipal rules and regulations, when a customer or applicant refuses or neglects to provide reasonable access to the premises, for fraudulent or illegal use of service, or for non-payment of bills. If discontinuance is for non-payment of bills, the customer shall be given at least forty-eight hours written notice, separate from the original bill, and cut-off shall be effected not less than twenty (20) days after the mailing date of the original bill, unless, prior to discontinuance, a residential customer presents to the utility a written certificate, signed by a physician, registered nurse, or public health officer, that such discontinuance will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity on the affected premises, in which case discontinuance may not be effected until the affected resident can make other living arrangements or until not less than ten (10) days elapse from the date of the Utility's notification. When a dangerous condition is found to exist on the customer's or applicant's premises, the service shall be cut off without notice or refused.

LEAK ADJUSTMENT POLICY

1. The following leak adjustment shall be made for residential customers:

(A) One (1) adjustment in a twelve (12) month period shall be allowed upon proof of unintentional cause of leak and correction of said problem, i.e. meter reader verification, plumbing receipt and/or materials for customer repair.

(B) Six (6) months previous consumption average shall be paid by customer (if this history of usage is not available the Water District average shall apply).

(C) The leak amount (amount exceeding average) shall be divided (\div) by two (2) and the customer shall pay this amount plus average.

Example: 2,000 gallons = \$15.10 6 months average
4,000 gallons leak \div 2 = 2,000 gallons @ \$6.75 per
thousand gallons = \$28.60

This amount will effectively cover our cost estimate of \$2.00 per thousand gallons for production.

DEPOSITS

The Company may require a minimum cash deposit or other guaranty to secure payment of bills

Service may be refused or discontinued for failure to pay the requested deposit. Interest, as prescribed by KRS 278.460, will be paid annually either by refund or credit to the customer's bill, except that no refund or credit will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent on the anniversary date of the deposit.

The deposit may be waived upon a customer's showing of satisfactory credit or payment history, and required deposits will be returned after one (1) year if the customer has established a satisfactory payment record for that period. If a deposit has been waived or returned and the customer fails to maintain a satisfactory payment record, a deposit may then be required. The Company may require a deposit in addition to the initial deposit if the customer's classification of service changes or if there is a substantial change in usage. Upon termination of service, the deposit, any principal amounts, and any interest earned and owing will be credited to the final bill with any remainder refunded to the customer.

In determining whether a deposit will be required or waived, the following criteria will be considered:

1. Previous payment history with the Company. If the customer has no previous history with the Company, statements from other utilities, banks, etc. may be presented by the customer as evidence of good credit.
2. Whether the customer has an established income or line of credit.
3. Length of time the customer has resided or been located in the area.
4. Whether the customer owns property in the area.
5. Whether the customer has filed bankruptcy proceedings within the last seven years.
6. Whether another customer with a good payment history is willing to sign as a guarantor for an amount equal to the required deposit.

If a deposit is held longer than 18 months, the deposit will be recalculated at the customer's request based on the customer's actual usage. If the deposit on account differs from the recalculated amount by more than \$10.00 for a residential customer or 10 percent for a non-residential customer, the Company may collect any underpayment and shall refund any overpayment by check or credit to the customer's bill. No refund will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent at the time of the recalculation.

1 Water districts should substitute KRS 74.050 and water associations should substitute KRS 273.392 since these statutes govern the rate of interest to be paid by water districts and associations.

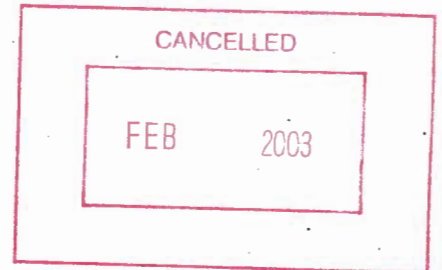

MONITORING OF CUSTOMER USAGE

At least once annually the Company will monitor the usage of each customer according to the following procedure:

1. The customer's annual usage for the most recent 12-month period will be compared with the annual usage for the 12 months immediately preceding that period.
2. If the annual usage for the two periods are substantially the same or if any difference is known to be attributed to unique circumstances, such as unusual weather conditions, common to all customers, no further review will be done.
3. If the annual usages differ by 50 percent or more and cannot be attributed to a readily identified common cause, the Company will compare the customer's monthly usage records for the 12-month period with the monthly usage for the same months of the preceding year.
4. If the cause for the usage deviation cannot be determined from analysis of the customer's meter reading and billing records, the Company will contact the customer by telephone or in writing to determine whether there have been changes such as different number of household members or work staff, additional or different appliances, changes in business volume, or known leaks in the customer's service line.
5. Where the deviation is not otherwise explained, the Company will test the customer's meter to determine whether it shows an average error greater than 2 percent fast or slow.
6. The Company will notify the customers of the investigation, its findings, and any refunds or backbilling in accordance with 807 KAR 5:006, Section 10(4) and (5).

In addition to the annual monitoring, the Company will immediately investigate usage deviations brought to its attention as a result of its on-going meter reading or billing processes or customer inquiry.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

SCHEDULE OF SPECIAL SERVICE CHARGES

The following charges for special services shall be made:

1. Service Connection Charge. A charge of \$70.00 (\$20.00 service, \$50.00 deposit) shall be made during regular working hours, except that there shall be no connection charges made for service on the original installation of facilities. If service is reconnected other than during regular working hours, the charge shall be \$76.50.
2. Delinquent Service Charge. A charge of \$20.00 shall be made for a trip to disconnect a delinquent account. A reconnection charge of \$20.00 shall be made if reconnected during regular working hours. If reconnected after regular working hours, the charge shall be \$26.50, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:006, Section 8 (3)(c).
3. Meter Recheck Charge. A charge of \$15.00 shall be made for a trip to recheck a meter reading when the customer requests the meter to be rechecked for a correct reading and the meter was not misread.
4. Meter Test Request. Upon the request and payment of \$25.00 a customer may have his meter tested provided request by the customer is not more frequent than once each twelve months. If such test shows the meter to be more than two percent fast, a refund of the \$25.00 charge shall be made and the bill adjusted accordingly.
5. PSC Meter Test Complaint. Any customer of the District may request a meter test by written application to the Commission.
6. Service Investigation Charge. A charge of \$25.00 per trip shall be made for service investigation during regular working hours if interruption of service is not caused by failure of District's facilities. The charge for investigation after working hours will be \$40.00 per trip. Any maintenance and repair of facilities beyond District's delivery point is the responsibility of the customer.
7. Returned Check Fee. 1st or 2nd offense, a \$10.00 fee shall be required. On 3rd offense a customer will be required to pay in cash or by money order.
8. Late Payments. Monthly water charges are due and payable on the 15th of each month. A 10% penalty will apply to all bills paid after this date.

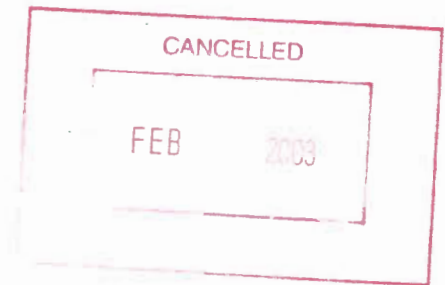
