- 3. Water service will be terminated within 24 hours after receiving a written request from the customer requesting discontinuance. Request for discontinuance may also be made in person. Water service will be terminated by phone provided customer gives their Social Security Number. The West McCracken Water District Office Hours are: 1st thru 10th of month, 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM, then 11th thru end of the month, 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM, closed Saturday, Sunday and Holidays.

5. The District may require any applicant for service to pay a cash deposit to assure payment of bills. This deposit will be based on average bills of similar customers in the District. This deposit shall not exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the estimated annual bill of such customer.

The District shall place the deposits in a special account where interest is allowed to compound. Interest gained on the deposits shall be refunded or credited to the customer's bill on an annual basis.

If the District retains a customer's deposit for more than eighteen (18) months, the District shall notify the customer in writing that, at the customer's request, the deposit will be recalculated every eighteen (18) months based on the customer's actual usage. If the deposit on account with the District differs by more than ten dollars (\$10.00) for residential customers, or more than ten percent (10%) for nonresidential customers, from the deposit calculated from actual usage, then the District shall refund any over payment and may collect any under payment by a credit or an addition to the customer's bill.

The District requires a customer applying for service to sign a Contract For Water Service. A copy of this Contract is contained on the next page.

For <u>NEW</u> meter installations, the WATER USER agrees to contract <u>for service for no less than one year</u>, if a main extension is required. The WATER USER agrees to pay at least a minimum monthly bill after the meter is installed until such time when the service is disconnected by a person acting on behalf of the SUPPLIER. Notice must be given to the SUPPLIER whenever the WATER USER desires to discontinue water service. Following installation of the water service, the meter will not be installed and service turned on until the WATER USER has installed his service line and provided the SUPPLIER with a copy of the inspection permit. The WATER USER will receive a water bill beginning with the first billing period following installation of the meter.

The WATER USER agrees to permit the SUPPLIER to lay, maintain, repair, remove and disconnect a service line and meter, and read meters at a point on WATER USER'S property to be designated by the SUPPLIER for each signed connection with the right of ingress and egress on property. The WATER USER shall guarantee proper protection for the property of the SUPPLIER placed on the WATER USER'S premises and shall permit access to it only by authorized representatives of the SUPPLIER. Damages to the property of the SUPPLIER will be repaired at the expense of the WATER USER.

The WATER USER shall install and/or maintain at his own expense a service line which shall begin at the meter and extend to the dwelling or place of use. The service line shall be no less than 3/4" service pipe and all <u>NEW</u> service lines must be inspected by the plumbing inspector and a copy of the inspection permit must be on file with the SUPPLIER. The WATER USER agrees to install a shutoff valve adjacent to the service as required by the SUPPLIER.

A separate water meter must be installed for each residence.

The WATER USER agrees to comply with and be bound by the Articles, Bylaws, Rules and Regulations of the SUPPLIER, now in force, or as hereafter duly and legally supplemented, amended or changed.

<u>Payment Policy</u> - Nonpayment on or before stated due date will result in a penalty of 10% of the delinquent amount. Nonpayment within twenty days of the mailing date of the bill will result in water being shut off from the WATER USER'S property. Notice will be sent, by mail, to the WATER USER concerning this penalty. In the event it becomes necessary to discontinue water service, due to nonpayment, a fee will be charged for reconnection of the service. The WATER USER will also be required to pay all delinquent accounts and the original deposit paid may be increased.

The District shall in no event be held responsible for any claim made against it by reason of the breaking of any mains or service pipes or by reason of any other interruption of the supply of water caused by the failure of machinery or stoppage for necessary repairs or other reasons.

No person shall be entitled to damages nor a payment refund for any interruption of service which, in the option of the District, was deemed necessary.

The District shall make all reasonable efforts to eliminate interruptions of service, and when such interruptions occur, service will be re-established with the shortest possible delay. When service is interrupted, all customers affected by such interruption will be notified in advance whenever possible.

14. Meters are read each month beginning on or about the 20th day of the month.

15. Customers are billed each month on the first day of the month.

16. Bills are payable on or before the 15th day of each month. If bills are not paid within 15 days of date of billing, a penalty of 10% of the bill shall be added. Service will be discontinued if bills are not paid by the 20th day of the month. Five (5) days written notice will be given to customers before service is discontinued. An extension of 30 days is given a customer for an unpaid bill if a case of hardship is indicated.

A fee of \$20.00 shall be required to re-establish discontinued service during office hours. A fee of \$35.00 shall be required after office hours, holidays and weekends. This includes re-establishing service which was voluntarily discontinued and re-establishing service which was disconnected for nonpayment of bills. RULES AND I	REGULATIONS

20. Multiple Services

A. Permanent Single Family Dwellings.

Under no, circumstances shall more than one permanent single family residential dwelling be provided service through a single meter.

B. Commercial Trailer Park.

(1) <u>Definition</u>. A commercial trailer park shall be defined as two (2) or more units occupying a common parcel of land and producing revenue of two (2) or more units designated as a trailer park by the Kentucky Department Health for reasons of health and public welfare.

(2) <u>Minimum Bill</u>. Rates shall be the approved minimum rate for the meter size as established in B. (3).

(3) <u>Meter Size</u>. The utility shall determine the size of meter necessary to provide adequate services and the meter installation shall be paid for by the customer at the prescribed rate in effect. The following schedule of meter sizes and maximum number of trailer spaces shall be adopted as the basis for selection by the Water District under normal conditions:

Any additional charge for increasing the meter size at some future date shall be paid by the owner at the actual cost to the utility less any salvage value for the meter remove.

C. Multi-Family Dwellings

(1) <u>Definition</u>. A multi-family dwelling shall be defined as a permanent structure housing two or more families and producing revenue. Included in this definition are duplex, triplex, and apartment buildings.

(2) Minimum Bill. Rates shall be the approved minimum for the meter size in use.

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D. Other Combinations

Multiple service for a permanent single family residential dwelling in combination with one trailer home not otherwise classified as a commercial trailer park may be served from a single meter. The minimum rate shall be the approved minimum rate for the meter size in use.

21. Extension of Main

A. Normal Extension.

An extension of fifty feet or less along an existing road shall be made by the West McCracken Water District to its existing distribution main without charge for a prospective customer who shall apply for and contract to use service for one year or more and provide a guarantee for such service.

B. Other Extensions.

(1) When an extension of the West McCracken Water District's main to serve an applicant or group of applicants amounts to more than fifty feet per applicant, the District may require the total cost of the excessive' footage over fifty feet per customer to be deposited with the District by the applicant or the applicants, based on the average estimated cost per foot of the total extension. Cost of the total extension shall be established from accurate records of construction cost by the District, including materials, labor, supervision, engineering, testing, disinfection, water and such other cost incurred by the District and made available to the applicant or applicants receiving service.

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B. Other Extensions. (Continued)

(2) Each customer receiving service under such extension will be teimbursed under the following plan: Each year for a period of not less than ten (10) years, which for the putpose of rule shall be the refund period, the West HcGracken Water District shall refund to the customer or customers who paid for the excessive footage, the cost of fifty feet of the extension in place for each additional customer connected during the year whose service line is directly connected to the extension enstalled and not to extensions or laterals therefrom; but in no case shall the total amount refunded exceed the smount paid the District. After the end of the refund period, (10 Years) no refund will be made.

C. Extension To a Real Estate Subdivision.

(1) Applicants Cost of Extension. An applicant desiring an extension to a real estate subdivision will initially be required to deposit a minimum of \$500,00 with the District prior to the development of preliminary construction drawings and cost estimate by the District's authorized engineering representative. If after the development of this preliminary information, the applicant withdraws the application for the real estate subdivision extension, the excess deposit over and above the actual administrative costs incurred by the District on the extension up to the time of withdrawal will be refunded to Should the applicant desire to continue with the the applicant. extension, the District may require the total estimated cost of the The extension to be deposited with the District by the applicant. preliminary costs incurred by the District and the initial deposit paid by the applicant will be included in the total estimated costs The cost of the total and total required deposit, respectively. extension shall be established from accurate records of construction labor, supervision, cost by the District, including materials, engineering, testing, disinfection, water and such other costs incurred by the District. 21. C. Extension To a Real Estate Subdivision.

(1) Continued

the construction of the extionsion, the actual cost of the extension is less than the total amount deposited by the applicant, the excess shall be refunded to the applicant. If the actual total cost of the extension is greater than the total amount deposited with the District by the applicant, an amount equal to the excess in cost shall be deposited with the District prior to the District's final acceptance of the extension.

(2) Applicants Reimbursed for Cost of Extension.

Each year for a period of not less than ten (10) years, the West McCracken Water District shall refund to the applicant who paid for the extension a sum equivalent to the cost of fifty (50) feet of the extension installed for each additional customer connected during the year but in no case shall the total amount refunded exceed the amount paid to the District. After the end of the refund period from the completion of the extension (10 years), no refund will be required to be made.

D. Construction Procedure.

(1) Extensions by Water District. Water line extensions extended to customers under Item (A) Normal Extension; (B) Subdivision, shall be installed by the Water District's forces, or by a competent contractor employed by the Water District or by the person or persons desiring service and approved in writing by the District.

(2) <u>Construction Drawings</u>. Plans and specifications for proposed extensions shall be prepared by the West McGracken Water District's authorized engineering representative shall comply with the District's standards, shall meet the requirements of the Kentucky Denational of Health, the Fublic Service Commission and other applic Service Commission state, and local regulating agencies.

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21. D. (Continued)

(3) <u>Real Estate Subdivision Plats.</u> A reproducible plat of a real estate subdivision as recorded in the County Court Clerk's office shall be furnished by the developer for use by the District's Engineer in laying out the proposed water lines.

(4) <u>Utility Easements</u>. Water mains shall generally be laid in a 15 foot permanent easement on private property. A 15 foot temporary construction easement adjacent to the 15 foot permanent easement shall also be required where practical, from each private property owner. The cost of obtaining easements shall be included in the cost of construction as set forth in items 21B and 21C above.

(5) Service Lines and Service Connection Charges. Meters, meter boxes and service lines from the main to the meter will be installed by the Water District as required to customers adjacent to said main extensions, and the Water District shall be reimbursed for this service by the property owner in the form of a Service Connection Charge current at the time the service is made not withstanding the following:

a. The District may under certain circumstances, alter Service Gonnection Charges to exceed the standard Service Connection Charges in effect for the purposes of reimbursement to applicants desiring extensions under Item 21B, Other Extensions, and item 21C, Extensions to a Real Estate Subdivision, if said altered Service Connection Changes are approved by the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Public Service Commission.

(6) <u>Fotable Water-Maintenance of Lines.</u> After the mains have been Installed, tested, and chlorinated to the satisfaction of the Health Department, the West McGracken Water District shall then accept the responsibility for furnishing potable water to the extension and for maintenance of the lines including meters, meter boxes and service lines from the main to the meter. 21. D. (Continued)

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(7) <u>Rates</u>. Rates for furnishing water shall be the current rates then in effect for the West McCracken Water District in the area served and approved by the Public Service Commission.

E. Other Arrangements for Extensions.

Nothing contained herein shall be consued to prohibit the West McGracken Water District from making extensions under different 'arrangements provided such arrangements have been approved by the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Public Service Commission.

F. Extensions by the West McGracken Water District.

Nothing contained herein shall be consued as to prohibit the West McGracken Water District from making at its expense greater extensions than herein prescribed, should its judgement so dictate, provided like free extensions are made to other customers under silimar conditions.
